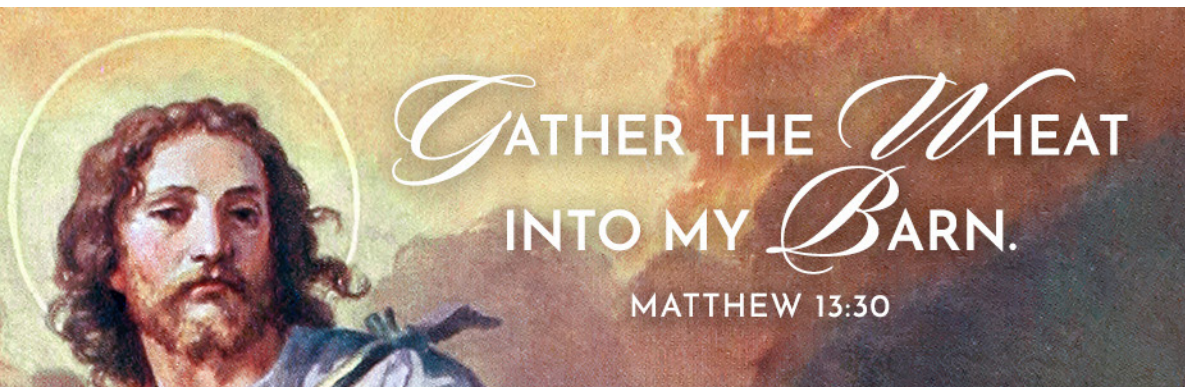


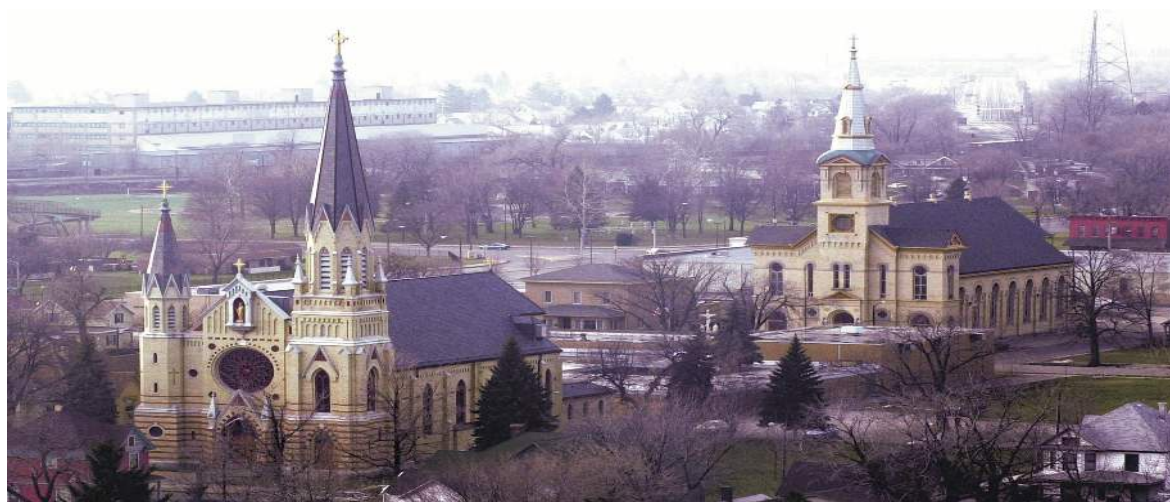

Parish Mission Statement

In fidelity to Jesus Christ, in 1858 Irish and German immigrants founded St. Patrick Parish—the Mother Parish of South Bend—and in 1877 Polish immigrants founded St. Hedwig Parish—the Mother Parish of the Polish Community of South Bend. Saint Patrick Parish and Saint Hedwig Parish combined as one parish with two historic churches on August 22, 2024. The Parish sets to the western edge of Downtown South Bend in the West Washington National Historic District. As a faith community, we seek to bring the gifts of these two traditions together as one in the Roman Catholic Rite—to proclaim the Gospel and to celebrate the Eucharist in order to strengthen our resolve and to seek to live the Gospel message and so enrich our lives and the lives of others, our neighborhood, and our workplaces.

From the Desk of Fr. Reginald Wolford, OP

An Introduction from our new Music Director:

Greetings, Fellow Parishioners!

Over the last few weeks, Fr. Reginald has written beautiful notes in the bulletin about sacred music and recent transitions in music in the life of the parish. I'd like to take this space to introduce myself, and provide a little more support for your singing during Mass.

Introduction

My name is Andrew Goldstein: I'm a parent of five (soon to be six!) with my wife Eryn. We moved to South Bend three years ago from Western Washington, and were attracted here by the Catholic community and family-friendly culture. I'm here at St. Patrick and St Hedwig part-time as a Music Director, and my full-time work is with The Vigil Project promoting both *devotional music* in the day to day lives of Catholics and *sacred music* at parishes around the world. If you don't see me in the loft on Sunday, I'm often traveling to help other parishes and music directors start up a sacred music program! Fun fact: I wrote a book about music in the home for Word on Fire, and it's coming out at the end of this year (musicadomestica.com) ... Music is a huge part of our family life at home, just as much as it is in my day to day work in the parish, and this book was an overflow of that gift of singing in our home!

Supporting Singing at Mass

Something I commonly hear is that chanting is beautiful, but scary to start doing! It's *okay* to feel that... I have often felt this fear myself. I want to encourage you to do two things. First, sing... even if it's imperfect. The Lord delights in your unique and unrepeatable voice. Second, listen... the Church's guiding document on music (*Musicam Sacram*, 1967) says that actively participating in the Mass is just as much an *interior* participation as it is an *exterior* one.

Each week, I will publish in the bulletin a list of the Ordinary (part of the Mass that don't change each week; the Kyrie, Gloria, etc.) and Propers (parts of the Mass that do change; the hymns and antiphons) for each given Sunday, and will include listening links. My hope is that you can utilize this not only to participate in song here in the Mass, but to let that gift of music overflow into your home throughout the week.

For Those Called to Serve

Lastly, *all* of us are called to *sing*, but a few people at every Mass are specifically called to *serve*. If the Lord is asking you to serve, I am training cantors and singers for each Mass time, and would love to speak with you. Email me: andyrgoldstein@gmail.com to set up a time to talk!
