In fidelity to Jesus Christ, in 1858 Irish and German immigrants founded St. Patrick Parish—the Mother Parish of South Bend—and in 1877 Polish immigrants founded St. Hedwig Parish—the Mother Parish of the Polish Community of South Bend. Saint Patrick Parish and Saint Hedwig Parish combined as one parish with two historic churches on August 22, 2024. The Parish sets to the western edge of Downtown South Bend in the West Washington National Historic District. As a faith community, we seek to bring the gifts of these two traditions together as one in the Roman Catholic Rite—to proclaim the Gospel and to celebrate the Eucharist in order to strengthen our resolve and to seek to live the Gospel message and so enrich our lives and the lives of others, our neighborhood, and our workplaces.

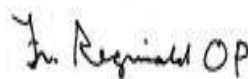
### From the Desk of Fr. Reginald Wolford, OP

Dear Friends,

As I write this, it is the feast day of St. Mary Magdalen. Did you know that she is sometimes called the Apostle to the Apostles? Why would that be? It is because she was sent (the word "apostle" comes from the Greek word for "sent") to give the news of the Lord's resurrection to the Apostles. Remember that scene in the Gospel - she came to the tomb weeping, and Jesus spoke to her and sent her. Let us remember that, even times of grief and doubt, the Lord has a plan and a mission for us. With the whole Church, let us pray:

*O God, whose Only Begotten Son entrusted Mary Magdalene before all others with announcing the great joy of the Resurrection, grant, we pray, that through her intercession and example we may proclaim the living Christ and come to see him reigning in your glory.*

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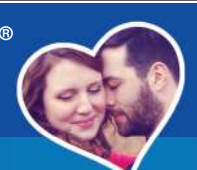
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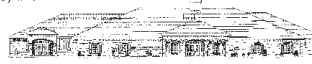
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
