

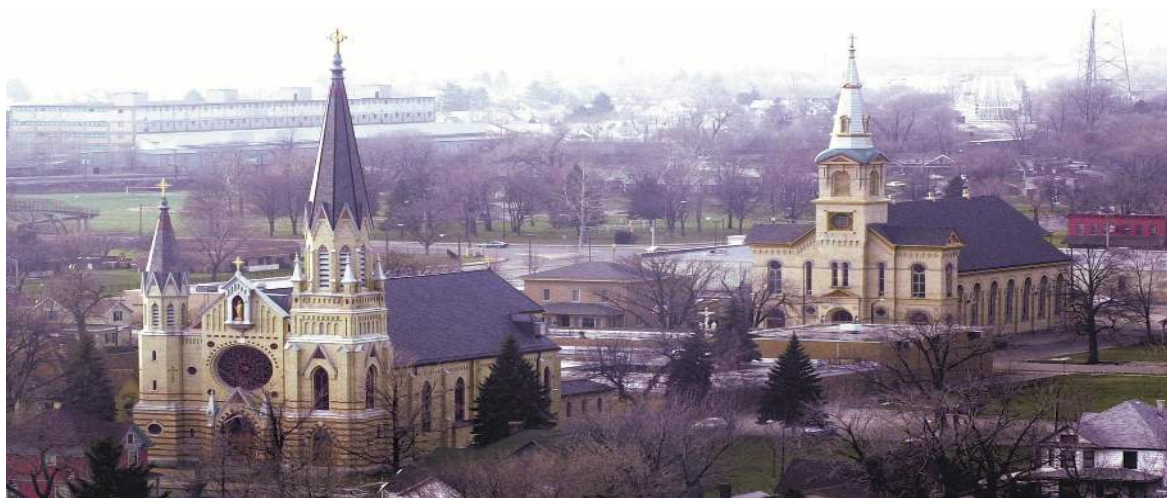

Parish Mission Statement

In fidelity to Jesus Christ, in 1858 Irish and German immigrants founded St. Patrick Parish—the Mother Parish of South Bend—and in 1877 Polish immigrants founded St. Hedwig Parish—the Mother Parish of the Polish Community of South Bend. Saint Patrick Parish and Saint Hedwig Parish combined as one parish with two historic churches on August 22, 2024. The Parish sets to the western edge of Downtown South Bend in the West Washington National Historic District. As a faith community, we seek to bring the gifts of these two traditions together as one in the Roman Catholic Rite—to proclaim the Gospel and to celebrate the Eucharist in order to strengthen our resolve and to seek to live the Gospel message and so enrich our lives and the lives of others, our neighborhood, and our workplaces.

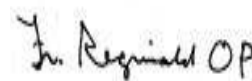

From the Desk of Fr. Reginald Wolford, OP

Dear Friends,

It is perhaps providential that, as I write this, it is the Memorial of Martha, Mary, and Lazarus. We know, of course, that Martha, in the Gospel story, was “anxious about many things”, while Mary sat at Jesus’s feet, listening to Him. Therefore Martha represents service, while Mary represents contemplation. I find the timing fitting because I will soon be on my yearly retreat. You will not see me much for the first half of August - after some Dominican business in Chicago, I will have a week of quiet prayer. We priests, as busy as we may be with serving God’s people, are required to make a retreat every year. The Church, in her wisdom, recognizes that we all need to take time to “unplug” and simply rest in the Lord. In this we are asked to practice the humility of recognizing that we are at the Lord’s work and not our own, so that we can come back to our duties with renewed strength and devotion. I assure you of my prayers on retreat, and I ask for yours, and I look forward to being with you again in a couple weeks. I also encourage you to make sure that you take some time away from your regular duties to rest in the Lord, after the example of Mary, who “chose the better part.”
