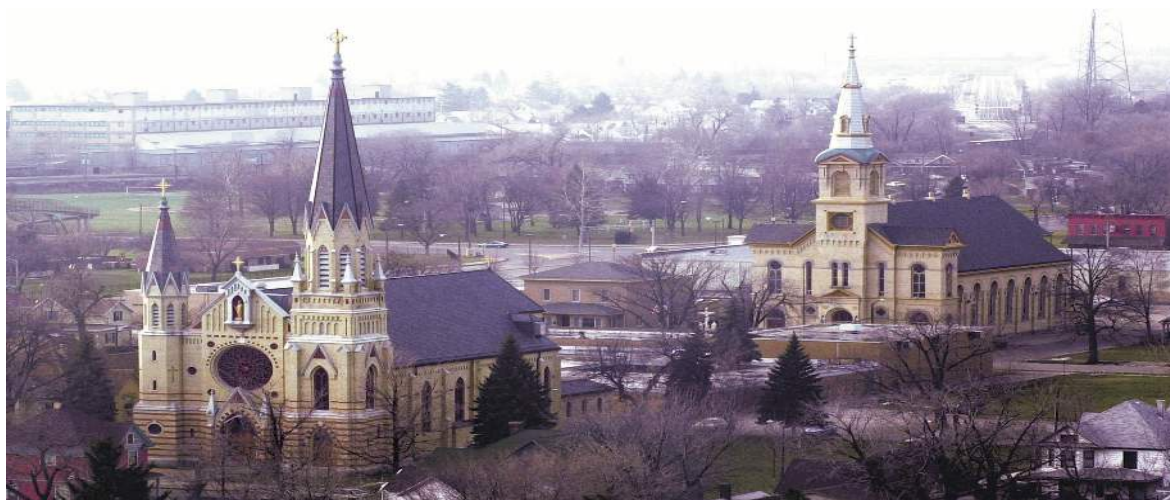

In fidelity to Jesus Christ, in 1858 Irish and German immigrants founded St. Patrick Parish—the Mother Parish of South Bend—and in 1877 Polish immigrants founded St. Hedwig Parish—the Mother Parish of the Polish Community of South Bend. Saint Patrick Parish and Saint Hedwig Parish combined as one parish with two historic churches on August 22, 2024. The Parish sets to the western edge of Downtown South Bend in the West Washington National Historic District. As a faith community, we seek to bring the gifts of these two traditions together as one in the Roman Catholic Rite—to proclaim the Gospel and to celebrate the Eucharist in order to strengthen our resolve and to seek to live the Gospel message and so enrich our lives and the lives of others, our neighborhood, and our workplaces.

"Late have I loved you..."

Dear friends,

As I write this, we are about to celebrate the feast of St. Augustine in a couple days. Augustine, of course, is one of the greatest Fathers of the Church, and was a bishop in the then-Christian area of North Africa. His writings - dealing with all the theological controversies of the early centuries of the Church, are still widely respected today.

After a wild youth, falling into some of the typical vices of a young man, and with ambitions of making a name for himself in the Empire, he had a deep conversion to Jesus Christ. In the above quote, from his book, *The Confessions* - basically meaning an autobiography - he reflects on how he agonized over his desire to come to Jesus, while still being attached to the world. With the Lord's persistence and the help of his mother Monica's tearful prayers, Augustine finally became the saint that we know today.

The story of St. Monica and St. Augustine should give us great hope. Pray hard for your family members that need to come, or return, to Jesus.

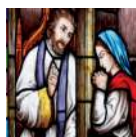
