Eyes Fixed on Jesus

Dear Friends,

I would like to share some news with you: I have requested, and been given permission, to make a change in the arrangement of the sanctuary at St. Hedwig Church. Within a few weeks (i.e. as soon as we can get it done) the tabernacle and the cross will be placed in the center of the back wall of the sanctuary. This is in accord with the traditional look of Catholic churches, and with the instructions of the Church - the Code of Canon Law states, "The tabernacle in which the Most Holy Eucharist is reserved is to be situated in some part of the church or oratory which is distinguished, conspicuous, beautifully decorated, and suitable for prayer" (CIC 938 §2). While the Church allows for other arrangements, the preference in the Diocese of Fort Wayne-South Bend is that the tabernacle be centered. This centrality can serve as a visual reminder of the centrality of Jesus and his Incarnation in our Faith, as well as the incredible gift of his presence in the Blessed Sacrament. As we read in the letter to the Hebrews, "Let us keep our eyes fixed on Jesus" (12:2).

Let me take this opportunity to express my gratitude that I am allowed to celebrate mass in churches as beautiful as St. Patrick and St. Hedwig. They are truly gems of South Bend and places that glorify God. When I walk up Wayne Street from the downtown area my heart is lifted up when I see the spires of our churches reaching up to Heaven. May the new sanctuary arrangement help us all to keep our eyes fixed on Jesus.
