Identifying SEND

- We support needs in: Communication & Interaction, Cognition & Learning, Social, Emotional & Mental Health, Sensory & Physical.
- A child may need support if progress is slower than expected, gaps widen, or concerns are raised by parents or staff.

Supporting Your Child

- Children on the SEND register have a Send Support Plan reviewed termly.
- Parents of children on the SEND register have regular meetings with staff and work together with staff to create the SEND Support Plans.
- Children with EHCPs have an Annual Review.
- Support may include adapted teaching, small groups, 1:1 help, or specialist services.
- We work with Speech & Language Therapy, Educational Psychology, Occupational Therapy, and more.

Wellbeing & Inclusion

- We support emotional wellbeing through anti-bullying, inclusion in clubs and trips, and nurture groups.

Transitions

- Support is provided for starting school, changing year groups, and moving to secondary school.

Contact & Concerns

- Your child's class teacher is your first point of contact.
- If concerns remain, speak to the SENCo or Headteacher.
