Accessibility

- Update outdated and unreliable elevator.
- Create new, easily found entrance with staircase and elevator to the parish hall.
- Enlarge vestibules at the side entrances of the church and add restrooms.

Functionality

- Add vesting areas for clergy and servers as well as work spaces for ushers and greeters by the Narthex.
- Renovate old locker rooms to accommodate more meeting, storage, and office spaces.

Hospitality

- Create welcoming and focused entrances to the church and parish hall.
- Relocate the baptismal font and confessionals to the main entrance of the church.
- Modernize flooring and finishes throughout parish center.

Beauty

- Preserve sacred architectural elements in the church (wood ceilings, beams, etc.) and add complementary elements that promote prayer and meditation as well as help focus attention during worship.
- Update interior finishes and fixtures of the church to provide a cohesive style with the new walls and windows.
- Provide new shrines for statues and votive candles.

Safety

- Simplify the sanctuary layout into one level for ministers and clergy.
- Renovate half of the gym to relocate Anna's food pantry.

Efficiency

- Replace deteriorated windowed walls.
- Install new heating and air conditioning.
- Install new lighting and updated sound system.

Beauty

- Add sacred architectural elements to the church that promote prayer and meditation as well as help focus attention during worship
- Update interior finishes and fixtures of the church to provide a cohesive style
- Enhance the area around the baptismal font

Functionality

- Create three clergy suites (bedroom, sitting room, and bathroom) in the new rectory for the pastor, parochial vicar, and a retired priest or pastoral year seminarian
- Create a guest suite in the new rectory for visiting clergy (e.g., missionary priest)

Hospitality

- Create a welcoming and focused entrance to the church

Efficiency

- Install a durable floor that adds beauty to the worship space
- Update sound system in the church
- Address ice build up on the roofs of the church and parish center
