



Frequently Asked Questions

- 1 I don't have a partner, what can I do?**

- 2 Will there be any mixed doubles?**

Yes, this year we will have Men's, Women's and Mixed Doubles Divisions.

- 4 What if my partner and I are at different levels?**

You will be placed in the bracket of the higher-level player. For example, if you are an A-level player and your partner is a B-level player, your team will compete in the A bracket. (League levels will be verified.)

- 5 Can I change my partner on the day of the tournament?**

Yes, but your new partner must complete a waiver form and submit payment before participating.

- 6 **What is the last day a refund will be issued?** Refunds will be issued through Friday, October 6. No refunds will be given after this date.

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- 7 **What do I need to bring?** We recommend bringing a chair, plenty of drinks, snacks, and anything else that will help keep you comfortable and happy throughout the day.

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- 8 **How many matches will my partner and I play?** You'll be placed in a pod with 3–4 other doubles teams and will compete in a round-robin format. If you win your pod, you'll advance to the next round. Most teams will play a minimum of 3 matches and a maximum of 5–6, depending on the number of entries in your bracket.
