Hiring Agency:	City of East Grand Forks
Location:	Sherlock Park Swimming Pool
Who May Apply:	Open to all qualified job seekers 15+ years old with Lifeguard Certification, including CPR/AED, First Aid, and Lifeguard Training
Days of Work:	Varies, 11:00am – 8:30pm. Work days and hours vary and include weekends and holidays. Additional morning shifts may be required for pool rentals. Anticipated season is June thru August.
Wage:	\$16.60
Job Description:	This is a seasonal part-time position that monitors swimmers, enforces safety rules, and responds quickly to emergencies to prevent accidents and keep aquatic areas safe.

Duties include, but are not limited to:

- Supervises play on the pool deck and in the swimming pool, to ensure a safe environment for all patrons
- All lifeguards will participate in drills and in-service training sessions.
- Enforce all pool rules and keep consistent eviction policy.
- Demonstrate an ability to ensure public safety by monitoring and scanning assigned area, implementing preventive aquatic emergency procedures, and rescuing patrons in need of assistance
- Demonstrates an ability to perform pool storage and locker room cleaning tasks, work with a Certified Pool Operator to properly take water tests, and use other safety equipment in an efficient and safe manner.
- Demonstrates an ability to be flexible and adaptable to changes in work assignments.
- Demonstrates effective team membership by being self-motivated, accepting of assignments, and routinely taking the initiative to perform in an effective manner.
- Reports all injuries, accidents, or misbehavior incidents to the pool manager or assistant manager
- Completes incident reports and submits to supervisor in a timely and effective manner
- Performs related tasks as required.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Current lifeguard certification from a recognized organization (such as the American Red Cross or YMCA of the USA)
- CPR/AED and First Aid certification

- Ability to pass a swim skills and water rescue test
- Must provide own transportation to and from assigned work location
- Strong attention to safety and situational awareness
- Ability to remain alert for extended periods and respond quickly in emergencies
- Minimum age requirement of 15

Preferred Qualifications:

- Previous lifeguarding experience at a pool, beach, or aquatic facility
- Experience working with children, swim lessons, or aquatic programs
- Certification in Water Safety Instruction (WSI) or similar swim instruction credential
- Experience with pool operations or facility maintenance
- Strong customer service and communication skills
- Ability to assist with opening/closing duties, incident reporting, and rule enforcement
