Who May Apply:	Open to all qualified job seekers 15+ years old
Days of Work:	Varies, 8:00am – 9:00pm. Work days and hours vary and include weekends. Anticipated season is end of May thru end of July.
Wage:	\$11.46
Job Description:	Coach performs duties emphasizing skill development, fair play, teamwork, cooperation, sportsmanship, responsibility, and fun. Each participant should be provided the opportunity to play and learn the sport and its positions. The job is performed under the direction of the Recreation Coordinator and the respective Baseball, Softball, or Tennis Coordinator.

Duties include, but are not limited to:

- Teach fundamental skills to the youth participants while emphasizing skill development, fair play, teamwork, sportsmanship, and fun
- Be on time at all practices and games
- Provide a safe environment for practice and games by checking the condition of equipment each day
- Teach skills in developmentally appropriate stages
- Enforce all East Grand Forks Parks and Recreation Department policies and rules
- Be responsible for the children until they are picked up by a parent or guardian before leaving the field
- Provide proper first aid when injuries occur and notify the Parks and Recreation Department your kit needs replenishment; fill out and turn in accident report forms to the Parks office within 24 hours of when an injury occurs that requires more than simple first aid. Call 911 for any severe injury
- Report any issues with fields, equipment, player behavior, parent behavior, or officials to the Parks and Recreation Department
- Abide by all officials' decisions
- Perform other apparent duties as assigned

(The above listed tasks are intended only as illustrations of the various types of work performed. The omission of specific duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related, or a logical assignment to the position.)

Minimum Qualifications:

- Knowledge of the rules, fundamentals, and basic strategies of baseball, softball, and/or tennis

- Ability to safely instruct and supervise youth athletes during practices and games
- Ability to interact with the public in a professional manner
- Strong communication and leadership skills
- Ability to create and lead basic practices, drills, and skill development activities
- Ability to maintain a positive, safe, and inclusive environment for participants
- Ability to work for extended periods of time outdoors, in various weather conditions, as well as evening and weekend work.
- Willing to get dirty and/or wet
- Ability to lift 25+ lbs
- Ability to pass a background check

Preferred Qualifications:

- Previous coaching or playing experience in baseball, softball, or tennis
- Experience working with youth sports programs or recreation leagues
- Certification in First Aid/CPR
- Ability to teach skill progression, teamwork, and sportsmanship
- Experience with game scheduling, scorekeeping, or league coordination
