Iúnó Connolly

is emerging as a lyric coloratura of great charm and refined musicality. She was a prize winner at the 2023 Concorso Internazionale di Canto Voci Nuove per La Lirica G. Fraschini (Italy), and a finalist in both the International Haydn Singing Competition (Austria) and the Nico Dostal International Singing Competition (Austria).

Iúnó Connolly trained at the Royal Birmingham Conservatoire (BMus Hons), the Conservatorio di G.Frescobaldi, Ferrara and at the Royal Academy of Music (MA DipRAM), where she won the Elena Gehardt Lieder Prize. She is a Britten Pears and a British Youth Opera alumna.

UK engagements include: Grilletta (*The Apothecary*), Christalina (*La fiera di Venezia*), and Clarice (*Il mondo della luna*) for Bampton Classical Opera; Chocholka (*The Cunning Little Vixen*) at the Barnes Music Festival; Sarah Whitehead/Nun (*English Eccentric*), and Skokánek (*The Cunning Little Vixen*) for British Youth Opera; Giannetta (*L'elisir d'amore*) for IF Opera; cover (and cover showing) Brigitte (*Iolanta*) at Opera Holland Park and *A New Dark Age* at the Royal Opera House.

Recital engagements in the UK include: song recitals with Dylan Perez at the Chipping Camden International Music Festival and St Martin-in-the-Fields, and a lunchtime recital at Symphony Hall, Birmingham,

Shas performed as a soloist in Germany - Handel's *Samson* at Theater Heidelberg and a song cycle with Dylan Perez at the Heidelberger Frühling Festspiele; in Italy at the Teatro Comunale di Ferrara and il Teatro G. Fraschini, and in the United States - Carnegie Hall's Weill Recital Hall.

Recent engagements include: Elvira Puccini in William Niall Morris' *Puccini: Man of Theatre* at the Wexford Festival; A Schubertiade for the Schubert Society of Great Britain; Bach's B Minor Mass with le Concert d'astrée and l'orchestre de Paris at the Philharmonie de Paris under the baton of Klaus Mäkelä, as well as performances of the Brahms's *Requiem*, Poulenc's *Stabat Mater*, Haydn's *Creation* and Haydn's *Nelson Mass*, and her first Tatyana with the Semley Summer Music Festival.

Puccini: Man of Theatre, Wexford Festival

In character as Elvira, English soprano Iúnó Connolly sang ‘*In quelle trine morbide*’ from that opera – really good - **Edinburgh Music Review**

Soprano Iúnó Connolly gave a lively and expressive performance as Elvira, successfully capturing her changing moods. She possesses a colorful, resonant and flexible voice, which she employed intelligently in a number of pieces, including the aria “Il mio babbino caro” from “Gianni Schicchi,” which brought the opera to a close - **Opera Wire**

Singing with lovely directness, the tenor Guy Beynon and the soprano Iúnó Connolly captured the fresh style of Rasoio and Cristallina, which contrasts with the aristocrats’ high-flown *seria* rhetoric. Connolly’s happy acceptance of Rasoio’s marriage proposal rose sweetly above the deceptions and disorder, and her vibrant tone and characterful projection was to be admired throughout - **Opera Today**

Ariel, here more Puck than ethereal spirit, is sung with engaging lightness and fluency by Iúnó Connolly, counterbalancing the darkly incisive bass of Timothy Edlin as Caliban - **Bachtrack**
