#### **RE: Free Suicide Intervention Training**

Dear Community Partner,

Your local VFW Post 6449 and Engage Life Choices (ELC), both nonprofit organizations, have partnered to take action toward creating a suicide-safer community for the City of Fairburn and surrounding areas.

Suicide remains one of the leading causes of death in the United States and within the state of Georgia, affecting people of all ages and backgrounds. While these realities are serious, we believe strongly that prevention is possible when communities are equipped, aware, and willing to act.

Together, our organizations are combining trusted community leadership and proven prevention strategies to make a tangible difference. This initiative reflects our shared commitment to ensuring that individuals in our local community are not only supported—but that more people are equipped to respond when it matters most.

As part of this initiative, we are offering three (3) free Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training (ASIST) workshops to the community. April, July and October – detail on the flyer or on the registration link,

ASIST (Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training) is internationally recognized as the gold standard of suicide intervention. This evidence-based, two-day training equips participants with the skills to:

- Recognize when someone may be thinking about suicide
- Engage in a direct and supportive conversation
- Develop a safety plan that promotes immediate support
- Connect individuals to appropriate resources

Upon successful completion of the full two-day workshop, participants will receive a certification valid for three (3) years. Continuing Education Units (CEUs) are also available for eligible participants, offering up to 12 hours for an additional fee of \$73.

This training model has been used worldwide to equip individuals and communities with life-saving intervention skills.
