Adrenaline 1:10000 for IV/IO injection	Cardiac arrest
Amiodarone for injection	pVT/VF cardiac arrest
Aspirin tablets	Suspected cardiac chest pain
T. C.	General analgesia (at patient request)
Atropine for injection	Symptomatic bradycardia
Benzylpenicillin for injection	Suspected meningitis
Chlorphenamine for injection	Anaphylaxis

Clopidogrel tablets	Myocardial infarction

Oxygen for inhalation	Hypoxaemia
Paracetamol for infusion	Moderate/severe pain
Penthrox for inhalation	Severe pain

Salbutamol for injection	Life-threatening asthma
Salbutamol for nebulising	Acute wheeze

Salbutamol inhalers	Emergency supply to patients
