- **Zoll X Series Monitor**
 - 12-lead capability
 - Nasal & in-line ETCO₂
 - Manual defibrillation (adult & paediatric pads carried)

 - Cardioversion supported (no pacing option)
 - Zoll R Series (with Pacing) coming soon!

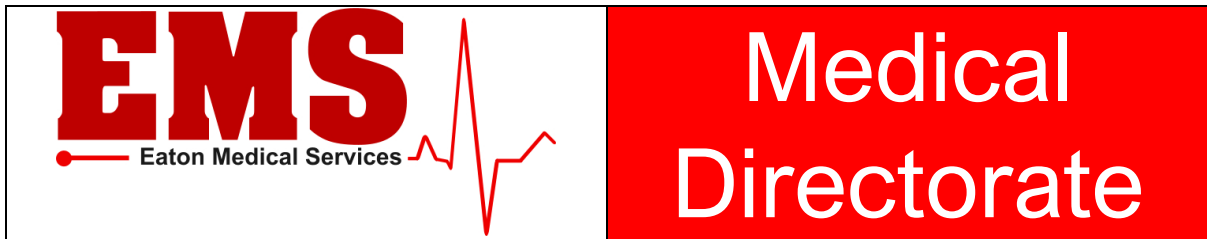
Emergency Drug List

Drug Name	Indication(s)
Activated Charcoal suspension	Oral overdose
Adenosine for injection	Termination of NCTs
Adrenaline 1:1000 for IM injection (also diluted for IV infusion)	Anaphylaxis Life-threatening asthma Refractory anaphylaxis (Infusion) Post-ROSC circulatory support (Infusion)
Adrenaline 1:10000 for IV/IO injection	Cardiac arrest
Amiodarone for injection	pVT/VF cardiac arrest Unstable tachyarrhythmias (Infusion)
Aspirin tablets	Suspected cardiac chest pain General analgesia (at patient request)
Atropine for injection	Symptomatic bradycardia OP/nerve agent poisoning
Benzylpenicillin for injection	Suspected meningitis
Calcium Chloride/Gluconate 10%	Severe hyperkalaemia PEA secondary to hyperkalaemia
Chlorphenamine for injection	Anaphylaxis Severe allergic reaction
Clopidogrel tablets	Myocardial infarction
Co-Amoxiclav for injection	Open long-bone/foot fracture Sepsis
Diazepam for injection	Seizure termination (if Midazolam unavailable) Cocaine toxicity (if Midazolam unavailable)
Diazepam for rectal administration	Seizure termination (if Midazolam unavailable and IV access not possible)
Diclofenac for injection	Alternative analgesia for moderate/severe pain
Furosemide for injection	Acute pulmonary oedema
Glucagon for IM injection	Hypoglycaemia (if IV access not possible)
Glucose 10% for infusion	Hypoglycaemia
Glyceryl Trinitrate (GTN) SL spray	Suspected cardiac chest pain
Hydrocortisone for injection	Anaphylaxis Severe asthma COPD exacerbation Adrenal crisis
Ipratropium Bromide for nebulising	Asthma/COPD exacerbation
Levetiracetam for injection	Convulsive status epilepticus
Lidocaine 1% for local anaesthesia	Wound exploration/irrigation/closure Digital ring blocks
Magnesium for Injection	Severe/life-threatening asthma Eclamptic seizures Polymorphic VT
Metaraminol for injection	Management of critical hypotension
Midazolam for injection	Seizure termination Cocaine toxicity Post-ROSC sedation Procedural sedation
Morphine for injection	Severe pain
Morphine oral suspension	Severe pain (if IV access not possible)

Naloxone for injection	Opiate overdose
Nitrous Oxide for inhalation	Moderate/severe pain Fracture reduction
Ondansetron for injection	Nausea/vomiting
Oxygen for inhalation	Hypoxaemia
Paracetamol for infusion	Moderate/severe pain
Pentrox for inhalation	Severe pain Fracture reduction
Salbutamol for injection	Life-threatening asthma
Salbutamol for nebulising	Acute wheeze Asthma/COPD exacerbation
Salbutamol inhalers	Emergency supply to patients
Sodium Bicarbonate 8.4%	Refractory cardiac arrest secondary to hyperkalaemia or TCA overdose
Sodium Chloride for injection/infusion	Hypovolaemia/clinical shock Crush injuries Severe burns 2.7% hypertonic solution for raised ICP
Sodium Lactate Compound for infusion	Hypovolaemia/clinical shock Crush injuries Severe burns
Syntometrine for injection	Post-partum haemorrhage
Tranexamic Acid for injection	Life-threatening traumatic bleeding Severe head injuries (adults) Post-partum haemorrhage Severe bleeding post miscarriage
