



HYDRAULIC INFRASTRUCTURE UPGRADES TO HIDDEN VALLEY MOTORSPORTS COMPLEX CLIENT: DEPARTMENT OF INFRASTRUCTURE, PLANNING AND LOGISTICS

DARWIN REGION – HIDDEN VALLEY MOTORSPORTS COMPLEX CIVIL & EROSION CONTROL UPGRADES

CLIENT: DEPARTMENT OF INFRASTRUCTURE, PLANNING AND LOGISTICS

Works were aimed at remediating existing flood damage & minimise future damage. These works were broken down into several separate works;

Improvement 1: Retention basins in northern carpark

Improvement 2: Turn 1 erosion control – erosion control measures between turn 1 & 2. Construct earth mound level bank.

Improvement 3: Turn 1 surface runoff – earthworks re-contour & provide levee banks to redirect stormwater runoff away from the track at turn 1.

Improvement 4: Turn 2 to 4 embankment – construct a 600mm high rock barrier & reworked drain behind 1 line of protection.

Variation was included to construct a viewing mound at turn 10. Works included concrete footings, block work retainer walls, subsoil drainage, bulk filling, hand rail/balustrades, concrete slabs & associated works

DARWIN REGION – VANDERLIN DRIVE/LEANYER DRIVE – INTERSECTION AND SHARED PATH UPGRADE

CLIENT: DEPARTMENT OF INFRASTRUCTURE, PLANNING AND LOGISTICS

Upgrade of the Vanderlin Dr/Leanyer Dr intersection, the upgrade to the surrounding shared path as well as connectivity improvements to the Hibiscus Shopping Centre.

- Widening and installing new shared path out the front of Hibiscus Shopping town at Vanderlin/Leanyer intersection.
- Upgrades to intersection to better facilitate crossing along Leanyer Dr. Including enlargement of traffic island, new signage, signals installation, pavement marking.
- Removal of a light pole out of the way of the widening pathway, and the installation of 2 new light poles.
- Shifting back and reconstruction of kerb lines and drainage pit.
- Culvert installed under new section of path that currently is only grassed and free draining.
- Relocation of drain inlet pit.
- Installation of ramp and stairs out the front of the southern exit of Hibiscus
- Installation of a pedestrian fence along the Vanderlin Drive median.

- Upgrade to the internal road configuration to Lot 7824 to provide priority to traffic (i.e. buses) exiting Lot 7823 to Temple Terrace via Lot 7824
- Reconfigure car parking layout with increased number of carparks
- Amending site grading and drainage

DARWIN REGION – LUDMILLA CREEK CATCHMENT – FLOOD MITIGATION WORKS – CONSTRUCTION

CLIENT: DEPARTMENT OF INFRASTRUCTURE, PLANNING AND LOGISTICS

Works comprised of flood mitigation drainage upgrades in the areas of Dwyer Park, Reichardt Road, and Bishop Street.

A berm was constructed around the west, north & eastern sides of Dwyer Park. A shallow swale was constructed for water to drain from the park into the existing inlet structure. The existing inlet structure was upgraded with new concrete invert & steel grate for safety. Three raised pads were provided for future playground upgrades.

Upgrades to the Reichardt Road inlet structure consisting of raising concrete wall, installing a concrete wall 'weir' within the structure, and cutting a new weir in the existing concrete wall on the west side were carried out. From the Reichardt Road inlet structure a new concrete trapezoidal drain was constructed in the road verge west of Reichardt Road. Three 900 x 900 RCBC culverts were installed beneath Reichardt Road & Bishop Street, including new headwalls, & removal/plugging of existing stormwater infrastructure.

DARWIN – FISHERMAN'S WHARF – CONSTRUCTION OF CONCRETE PAVEMENT OF MR BARRA LANEWAY

CLIENT: DEPARTMENT OF INFRASTRUCTURE, PLANNING AND LOGISTICS

Works included clearing & grubbing, removal of existing asphalt, concrete & kerbing, earthworks in cut – cut area down to subgrade level. Electrical installation – streetlight conduits, pits, footings & light poles. Concrete pavement works – formwork, reinforcing install, placement, finishing & saw cutting. Stormwater – installation of main stormwater line and pits. Line marking and signage. CCTV installation works.

This project provided a challenging working environment due to the businesses within the laneway to remain in operation. We liaised with each business and DIPL to successfully deliver the works.

Supply of all Labour, materials and equipment required to carry out all necessary trenching and installation of below ground conduits and pit structures in preparation for the installation of underground cables, including backfilling, compacting and full reinstatement of existing surfaces.

OVERPASS AT TIGER BRENNAN AND BERRIMAH ROAD INTERSECTION
INTERSECTION UPGRADES TO – TIGER BRENNAN DRIVE/ WISHART ROAD / TIVENDALE ROAD
& WISHART ROAD/ KIRKLAND ROAD

CLIENT: SITZLER (SITZLER'S CLIENT DIPL)

Upgrade of intersections; Tiger Brennan Drive/Wishart Road/Tivendale Road and Wishart Road/Kirkland Road/Distribution Drive. Works were a critical pathway for the Tiger Brennan Overpass project to detour traffic. The works include the following upgrades:

- Upgrade the right turn lane from Tiger Brennan Drive to Wishart Road to be a dual signalised right turn. This includes widening Wishart Road to accommodate the required vehicle turn paths.
- Upgrade the left turn from Wishart Road onto the Tiger Brennan inbound carriageway to have two signalised left turn lanes.
- Upgrade the left turn from Wishart Road into Kirkland Road to have two signalised left turn lanes.
- Reconfigure the line making on Wishart Road to modify the existing

This project was a critical pathway for Sitzler's for their Tiger Brennan Overpass project. We collaborated with Sitzler's/DIPL Rep to overcome challenges, including ground condition issues and design modifications. The project was delivered within the agreed timeframe.

OVERPASS AT TIGER BRENNAN AND BERRIMAH ROAD INTERSECTION INTERSECTION UPGRADES TO TIVENDALE ROAD & STUART HIGHWAY CLIENT: SITZLER (SITZLER'S CLIENT DIPL)

Upgrade of the intersection at Tivendale Road and Stuart Highway. Works were to accommodate for the additional traffic expected at this intersection during construction of the Tiger Brennan Overpass project. Also to accommodate larger triple road train turning paths. Works included:

- Pavement widening to both left and right turning lanes
- Pavement construction including cement stabilised layers
- Concrete kerbing, raised concrete pavements and concrete islands
- Alterations and additional street lighting
- Telstra protection slabs
- Road furniture & line marking
- Traffic management including road closures
- Variation to mill and re-asphalt entire intersection


