Dear Mr. and Mrs.

I write in response to your recent request for an explanation of Maranatha High School's decision on January 24, 2022 not to re-enroll your children, ________, for the 2022-2023 school year. On that day we met and discussed the recurring nature of your family's interactions with employees at the school, including severe disrespect and disregard for school policies and procedures, particularly with regard to COVID safety protocols. As a Christian school, our values are essential to our mission and program. Therefore, not only students, but parents, must follow all school rules, and must interact with school employees in a respectful manner. Your interactions with school employees were disrespectful and disruptive, and have led me to conclude that the school does not have a reasonable partnership with you in educating your children.

After meeting and discussion this matter with you in January, you requested that the school allow your children to re-enroll for the 2022-2023 school year. The School decided that it would allow only to re-enroll because he was entering his senior year and would begin the college application process. This decision was made solely to assist your family. The decision to only allow enrollment for one of your children is final and is not subject to any appeal.

You may submit an application for for future enrollment. Please note that there is no guarantee the School will re-enroll any student and the School has sole discretion on admission and re-enrollment decisions.

While attends the school, we expect him and you to follow school rules. Please also understand that we expect your family to maintain a constructive attitude and to be supportive of the School, the administration, our employees, and students, when communicating with others. We have the same expectation of all families. Thank you.
