## Gutters Update

At the May board meeting there was discussion regarding the frequency of gutter cleaning, given the new larger gutters in Sections A and C.

**Please take note that going forward, gutter cleaning for Sections A & C will now be twice a year - March and October.**

**Section B will remain at four times a year until new gutters are installed.**

The most common cause of gutter overflow is blockage due to debris such as leaves, twigs, and dirt. When gutters are clogged, water cannot flow freely leading to overflow. Maintain your gutters & downspouts between HOA cleanings.



## Reminders:

**Trash pickup:  
Tuesday & Friday**

**Recycling pickup: Wednesday**

- Put out trash/recycling the morning of pick up in appropriate bins.
- Bins must be stored out of sight after pick-up.
- Yard debris in brown paper bags or leaf bags.
- Do not dump debris in natural areas.
- Trash company will not pick up piles of yard debris.
- Limbs, branches and sticks should be tied in bundles, no longer than 3 feet in length.
- Clean up after pets and dispose of bags in receptacle at your home.
- One trash can and 3 bags outside the can are allowable for trash pickup.
