It's time for Spring Cleaning!

- Remove planters from all wood areas, specifically under trellis/pergola
- Driveway and lanai screening cleaning *after the Pinellas water restrictions are lifted.*
- Seven planters/do-dads maximum per unit
- Think ahead and make a plan for hurricane season
June 1 to November 30
- Tree maintenance /Tall Palm tree trimming coming in May.
Regular tree trimming is a homeowner responsibility. All trees on your property are your responsibility to maintain if they were NOT planted by the developer or HOA. Refer to Pinewinds Rules & Regs. pages 12-13

- Trash and recycling out on the day of pick up, not earlier.
Tuesday and Friday is trash; Wednesday is recycling

In compliance with current watering restrictions, irrigation is running one day per week for each timer.

Timer 1 runs on Monday evenings:

Entrance
10-80 Pinewinds Blvd
10-120 Birdsong
70-120 Morning Dove

Timer 2 runs Saturday evenings:

Remainder of Pinewinds
Several off-cycle irrigation nodes will be adjusted at the end of the month to one day per week.
