"What if they sting you, won't your good times end?"



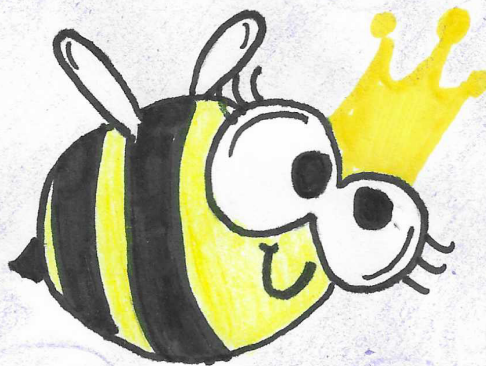
You see, bees don't want to sting you and me,

I'll tell you what **Honey, Buzz and I do with our days.**





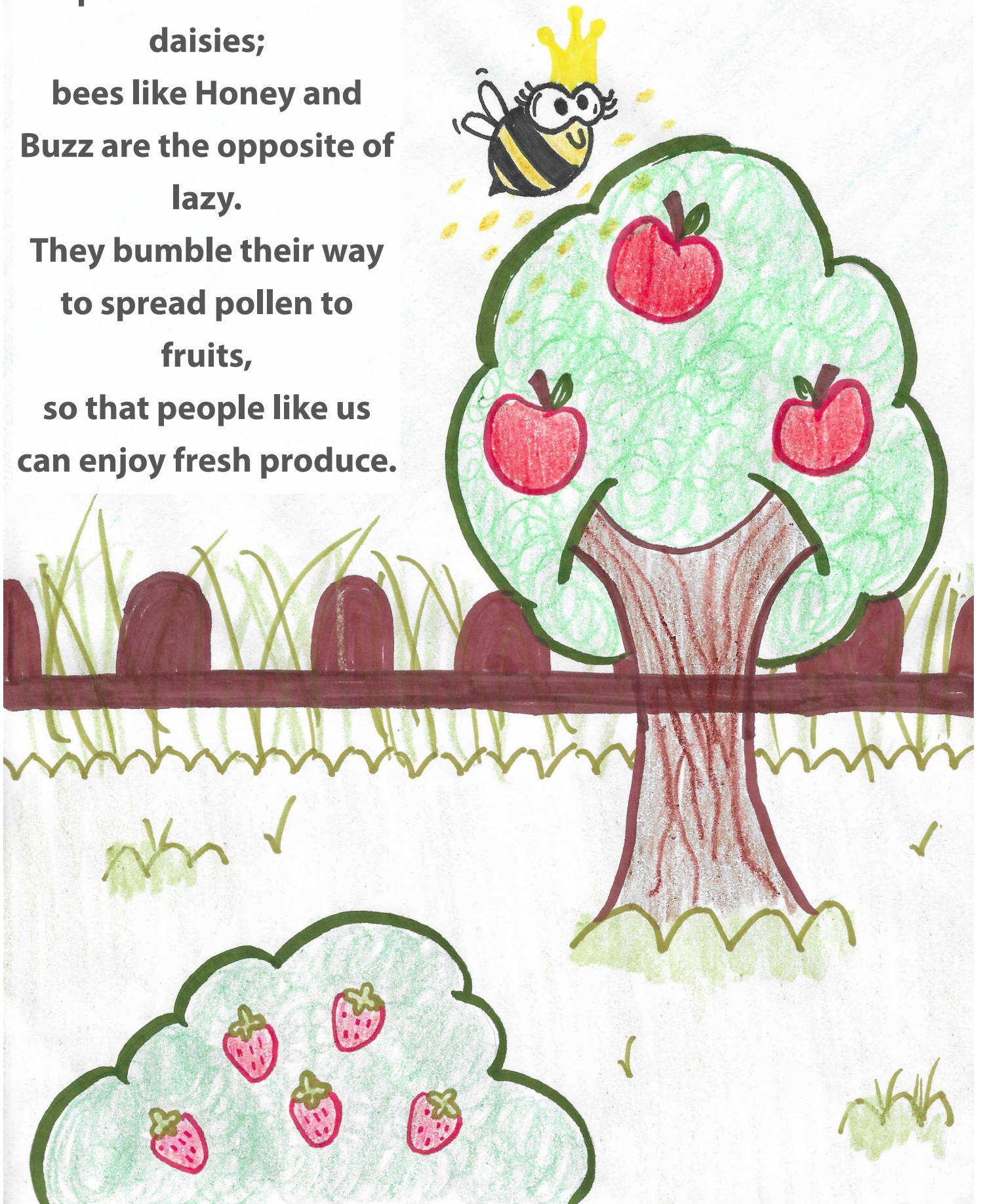
First, we start with our BEE-utiful flowers.

can enjoy fresh produce.**





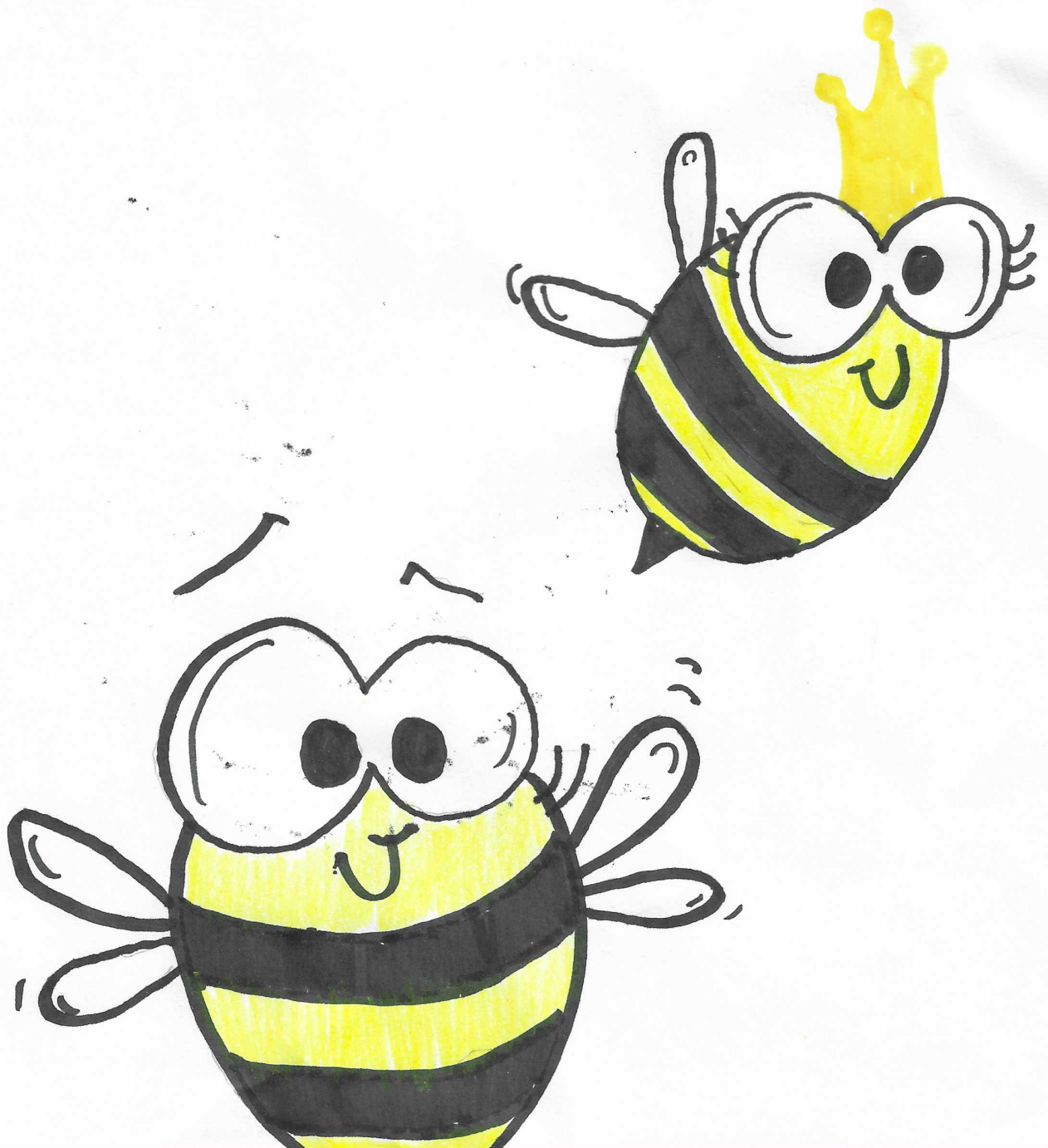
After all of this work we get a bit hungry,

flying it home,**

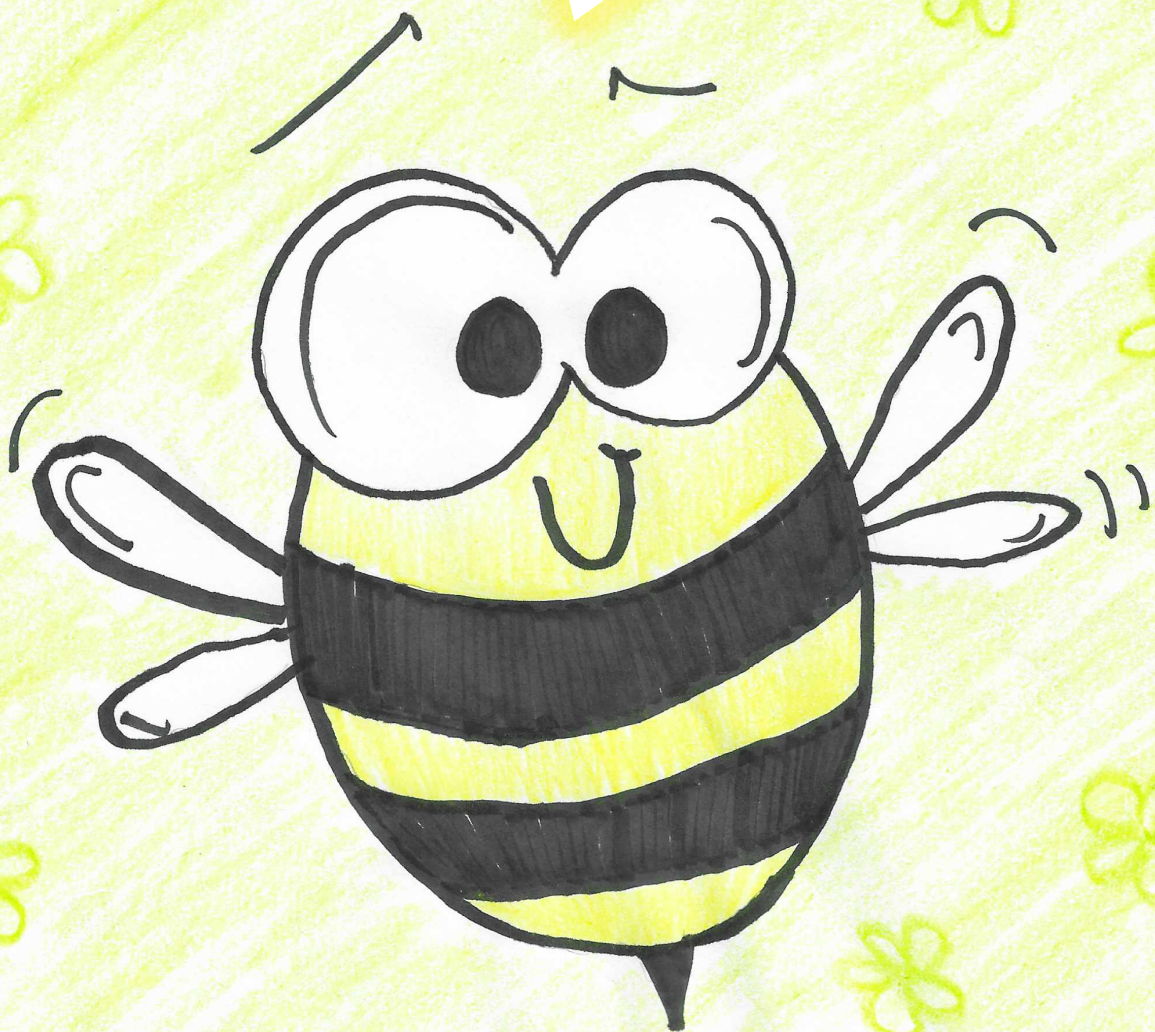


**bees create this sweet treat in
