# Policies: In-Person Classes for Grades One (1) through Five (5)

#### Attendance:

Attendance in Faith Formation classes is important and required for our children's spiritual growth. Please recognize the gifts of time, preparation, and generosity that our dedicated volunteer catechists offer to bring the good news to our children.

<u>Class begins immediately after the 9:30 AM Mass.</u> Children should attend Mass with their family. After Mass parents should walk the children to the school, entering through the back door. In late August/early September class assignments will be communicated. Please make note of the teacher and the room assignment as parents will be expected to escort their children to classrooms. **Children may bring a peanut/nut free snack if they wish.** 

Attendance is taken at the beginning of class. Please make every effort to have your child arrive on time and remain for the entire class. Please be sure to attend Mass, as it is part of your child's Faith Formation.

Any students in Grade One (1) through Five (5) who miss a scheduled Faith Formation class, will be required to complete make-up work (chapters covered when absent) prior to the following class. Teachers/FF team will check workbooks for completion when classes are missed. Please note, every time a student misses a class after the second time, they will be required to complete an assignment in addition to completing the workbook chapters missed before returning to the next class. Please note that if numerous classes are missed, workbooks/assignments are not completed, or it's apparent by a child's response to the assignments that they do not have a good understanding of material missed during the year, a child may not be able to advance to the next grade level.

In case of a known absence, please contact your child's catechist in advance. It is your child's responsibility to complete all missed assigned readings, classwork and homework assignments.

Children will be dismissed at 11:30am. Please park in the church parking lot. Parents will enter the back door of the school and collect their children from their classroom.

Children are required once a year to attend Reconciliation. If a sacramental year, (grade 2 - they are required to go twice).

January 24<sup>th</sup> - 2<sup>nd</sup> graders only – 1<sup>st</sup> Reconciliation Ceremony at 9:30am (no alternative dates will be given so please mark your calendars.)

Attendance is taken at the beginning of class. Please make every effort to have your child arrive on time and remain in class for the entire time. Please be sure to attend Mass, as it is part of your child's Faith Formation.

Students in grades Six (6) through Eight (8) who miss a scheduled Faith Formation class will be required to complete make-up work (chapters covered when absent) prior to the following class. Teachers/FF team will check workbooks for completion when classes are missed. Please note, every time a student misses a class after the second time, they will be required to complete an assignment in addition to completing the workbook chapters missed before returning to the next class. If your child has <u>NOT</u> received a Sacrament at Our Lady of Fatima Church (Baptism and/or First Communion), a copy of his/her baptismal certificate <u>must</u> be submitted to the Faith Formation office.

#### **Grade Six (2025-2026)**

By March of 2026 each Candidate will be expected to have completed 6 total Acts of Mercy/Service hours, some of which must be for Our Lady of Fatima church.

- We encourage all students to stay on top of completing these hours, so it is not overwhelming come 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade. We do **NOT** collect Report Forms until the end of 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Please fill out the report form when the service is completed and file it until later submitted.
- <u>Upon service completion</u>, fill out the Acts of Mercy/Service Report Form, which includes a one-paragraph description for each type of service (4-5 sentences minimum). <u>How did the service help others? In what way can I continue to serve others in a similar manner? How did it bring me closer to God?</u>
- A supervisor's signature is needed, indicating the number of hours of service.

# Grade 7 (2025-2026)

By March of 2026 each Candidate will be expected to have completed 16 total service hours (6 of these hours should have been completed in 6<sup>th</sup> grade), some of which must be for Our Lady of Fatima Church.

- We encourage all students to stay on top of completing these hours, so it is not overwhelming come 8<sup>th</sup> grade. We do <u>NOT</u> collect Report Forms until the end of 8<sup>th</sup> grade. <u>Please fill out the report form when the service is completed and file it</u> until later submitted.
- <u>Upon service completion</u>, fill out the Acts of Mercy/Service Report Form, which includes a one-paragraph description for each type of service (4-5 sentences minimum). <u>How did the service help others? In what way can I continue to serve others in a similar manner? How did it bring me closer to God?</u>
- A supervisor's signature is needed, indicating the number of hours of service.

For current Grade 8 (2025-2026)

By March of 2026 each Candidate will be expected to have completed 30 total Acts of Mercy/Service hours (16 should have been completed prior to 8<sup>th</sup> grade), some of which must be for Our Lady of Fatima Church.

- Upon service completion, fill out the Report Form, which includes a one-paragraph description for each type of service (4-5 sentences minimum). How did the service help others? In what way can I continue to serve others in a similar manner? How did it bring me closer to God?
- A supervisor's signature is needed, indicating the number of hours of service.

#### GRADE EIGHT: THE CHURCH THEN AND NOW / DECISION POINT TEXTBOOK

The Grade Eight Program strives to deepen student understanding of the Church through a study of its history by examining Scriptural images and models, the saints, commandments and virtues that enable us to give witness as members. These young adults see how the Church has been guided by the Holy Spirit throughout the ages, in good times and in bad times.

Decision Point is a Confirmation preparation program for young Catholics between 12 and 18 years of age. It is designed to engage this age group to "meet them where they are and lead them to where God is calling them to be." The program is experienced through short films which lead to class or small group discussions. There is a workbook with additional material for reflection and journaling. Our teens will hopefully rediscover their Catholic faith through this program.
