



Parent Agreement

We take this agreement seriously and ask that you do the same.

Requirements:

- The family will attend mass on a weekly basis. This is an obligation that all Catholics must fulfill.
- Parents are responsible for their child bringing the workbook to class every week.
- Any missed class lessons must be made up and taught at home by a parent/guardian.
Parents/guardians are responsible for contacting the catechist to receive the chapter/lesson work.
- Parents/guardians agree and will adhere to all drop-off and pick-up policies as outlined below.

Class/Session Placement Reminders:

- Any changes or desire to change a student's class assignment must be authorized by the Faith Formation office only and submitted in writing.
- Catechists do not have the authorization to allow new/additional students into their classroom, nor to move a student to another classroom. No Student is allowed in a class unless he/she is registered for that class.

First Day of Class for elementary aged children (grades 1 –5):

- After dropping your children off in their classrooms on the first day, we ask that you join us in the school gymnasium for a brief meeting

Drop-off and Pick-up Procedures:

The safety of all Faith Formation children is our first priority.

- All children are to enter the school building using the rear entrance by the modulars and playground.
- Children should only enter the front door of the school if they are late to class as the rear door will not be accessible once classes have started.
- Children in grades 1-5 must be accompanied to the classroom by a parent or guardian. Children are not permitted to walk through the parking lots unattended.
 - These same children must be picked up at the classroom. Children will not be permitted to leave the class without a parent/guardian.
 - Please do not arrive too early for dismissal nor wait directly in front of the classroom as it can be a disruption to both the catechist and students.
- Children in grades 6-8 will be dismissed from the rear doors of the school.
- Unless it is an absolute necessity, DO NOT pick up your child early from class, as this is a disruption to both the catechist and students. **Please be respectful of the time that we need to teach our students.** If you must pick up early, an early dismissal form must be provided to the catechist.
