SeniorLink is a prevention and early intervention program designed to provide support services to older adults (55+) experiencing isolation or early signs of depression and anxiety. After 15 years of dedicated service to our community, SeniorLink will be closing services on **June 30, 2026**. The program will not be accepting new referrals after **April 20, 2026**.

SeniorLink will remain fully operational and continue providing services throughout this transition period until June 30, 2026.

Over the past 15 years, it has been an incredible journey working alongside our community members, participants, and partners. We extend our deepest gratitude to all who have been part of SeniorLink, especially the older adults we have had the privilege to serve. Your trust, resilience, and engagement have been at the heart of this program.
