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1. Mississauga Health Primary Care Network (MH PCN)

What to expect:

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2. SCOPE Hub

What to expect:

- Seamless Care Optimizing the Patient Experience (SCOPE) quickly connects PCPs to local providers who can assist with urgent cases:
 - Consultations
 - Diagnostic imaging
 - Curated home and community care
 - Mental health
 - Navigating other services available in acute care or in the community

How to join SCOPE Hub:

1. Navigate to <https://wcredcap.wchospital.ca/surveys/?s=XW8N4KFAWX>.
2. Scroll through the form and fill in the mandatory fields.
3. Click "Submit" once all fields are filled in.
4. Once you are registered, you will receive a welcome email with billing codes, one-pager of the services SCOPE Hub offers and the phone number to contact to access services.

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3. ONE ID

What to expect:

- ONE ID credentials gain access to online digital health services offered by eHealth Ontario and other digital health solution providers.

How to sign up for ONE ID:

1. Review the ONE ID Registration Guide: https://ehealthontario.on.ca/files/public/support/ONE_ID/Registration_Community/one_id_cpso_registration_guide.pdf for a step by step guide on the ONE ID process.
2. Navigate to CPSO website <https://www.cpso.on.ca/en> to register through your CPSO Member Portal.
3. Log into CPSO using your account credentials.
4. To begin the ONE® ID CPSO Self-Registration process, navigate to the "Register for Ontario Health's ONE ID" section and review the information provided.
5. Once you have reviewed the necessary information, agree to the consent statement and click on the "Sign Up for ONE ID" button.
6. Follow the prompts from 1-7 of the ONE ID registration and click "Finish"
7. You will receive a login ID. You will need your Login ID and Password to log into your ONE® ID account <https://oneid.ehealthontario.ca/login>

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4. eConsults

What to expect:

- The eConsult program enables physicians to consult with specialists across the province to get faster access to advice for patient care. results from hospitals, community labs and public health labs.

How to signup for eConsults:

- To sign up use your ONEID and get same day access, go to otnhub.ca and visit the [OTNhub sign up](#) page to register.
- For physicians without a ONEID, you can register for one through your CPSO Member Portal. If you need assistance getting a ONEID please email eConsultCOE@toh.ca.
 - If required, you can also use this email to request a demo of how to use eConsults, once you are registered and set up.

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5. Connecting Ontario

What to expect:

- The Connecting Ontario Clinical Viewer is a secure, web-based portal that provides real-time access to digital health records including dispensed medications, laboratory results, hospital visits, Local Health Integration Networks' (LHIN) Home and Community Care Services, mental health care information, and diagnostic imaging reports and images.

How to sign into Connecting Ontario:

1. Navigate to <https://ehealthontario.on.ca/en/health-care-professionals/connectingontario>
2. Select the yellow "Sign into Connecting Ontario Clinical/Viewer" button on the right hand side of the page.
3. Sign in using your ONE ID account.

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6. Ontario Laboratories Information System (OLIS)

What to expect:

- The Ontario Laboratories Information System (OLIS) is an information repository that gives authorized health care providers access to lab test orders and results from hospitals, community labs and public health labs.

How to download OLIS:

1. Navigate to <https://ehealthontario.on.ca/en/standards/ontario-laboratories-information-system-standard>
2. Fill in your information on the right hand side of the page under the “Get Our Standards Package” section
3. Once all mandatory fields are filled in, click the “Agree and Download” button
4. Once downloaded, you will have access to your patients lab records.
5. As a final step, you can also connect OLIS with your EMR to pull laboratory data directly into your patient's chart.
6. If required, you can contact support@ontariomd.com for support in connecting OLIS with your EMR and/or request a demo of the application.

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7. PsychChat

What to expect:

- PsychChat aims to connect primary care providers and Psychiatrists via telephone for non urgent adult general psychiatry advice and recommendations for your patients.
- This Service is currently offered only to primary care providers practicing throughout Halton Region (Including Burlington) and Mississauga
- This Service is provided by Halton Healthcare affiliated psychiatrists
- Services offered:
 - General recommendations regarding assessment, management and treatment of mental health & addiction needs
 - Learning opportunities – education and practical advice
 - 5-10 minute brief telephone interaction

How to access PsychChat:

2. Scroll down and select the blue button "Ready to Start? Please complete the PsychChat referral form here"
