APRIL IS NATIONAL CAR CARE MONTH!

Winter weather can wreak havoc on vehicles, making it critical to give your vehicle proper attention and maintenance at the change of seasons. Below are four simple maintenance tasks you can complete yourself to ensure your vehicle is prepped and ready to hit the road as you leave winter in the rear view.

1. Check Your Motor Oil

- Park your car on level ground with the engine off and parking brake on; then lift the hood.
- Locate the dipstick (small colored handle with a motor oil symbol); pull it out and wipe off oil with a rag.
- Fully insert dipstick back into its tube; withdraw it again.
 - If oil level is anywhere between the two lines near the tip of the stick, you have enough motor oil.
 - If it's below the lower line, unscrew the Engine Oil Cap and add the oil viscosity recommended by your vehicle manufacturer.
 - Clean oil is amber or golden in color. If the oil appears dirty, black, or thick, it needs changing. Contact Allen's or Levrett for an appointment.

2. Check Tire Pressure



Manually check your tires when the seasons change as tire pressure can fluctuate with temperature changes.

- Purchase a tire pressure gauge to keep in your car.
- Locate the tire pressure placard (typically on the driver's side door jam).
- Push tire gauge against valve stem; as soon as the dial moves, remove tire gauge.
- Read gauge to see if it matches tire pressure listed on your placard; repeat on all tires.
- If pressure is low, use an air compressor at a gas station or service center to fill the tire. If it's dramatically low, get your vehicle to Allen's ASAP to check for a leak.

3. Check Your Lights

Turn on your vehicle and ensure it is in park.

- Check Headlights, High Beams & Fog Lights Exit the vehicle after turning on each of these lights to make sure each light properly illuminates.
- Check Hazard Lights Press the triangle-shaped button on your dashboard. Step out of your vehicle and make sure the lights are blinking on both sides.
- Check Turn Signals Activate each turn signal; make sure the signal within your
 dashboard is functioning, then exit the vehicle and check the turn signals are
 working on both the left and right sides, front and back.
- Check Tail Lights Have a friend stand behind your car while you tap on the breaks to make sure both rear lights are properly illuminated.



TIP: Many auto parts stores will install new wiper blades for free if you purchase them from that store.

4. Check/Replace Wiper Blades:

- Turn on your windshield wipers. If they are loud, rough or not properly cleaning the window, it's time to replace them.
- To replace wiper blades, first remove the old wipers by pulling up on a clip on top of the wiper blade or pushing down on a small tab on the side.
- Put on the new wiper blades by sliding them on in the opposite way the old wiper blades came off. When properly inserted, you will hear a click
- Test new wipers to make sure they work properly.
