



House of Grace Thailand

A Place of Rescue, Restoration, and Hope

House of Grace is more than a shelter—it's a safe, loving home where at-risk girls are rescued from exploitation and given a chance to thrive. Through education, counseling, and discipleship, each girl is nurtured in a Christ-centered environment that promotes healing and growth. With campuses in Thailand and Ghana, House of Grace empowers young women to break cycles of abuse and poverty. Every life changed is a testimony of God's redeeming love at work.



IMPACT STORY

Julianna's Story

From Orphaned Girl to Future Leader

In 2011, Julianna became the first girl to arrive at House of Grace—Ghana. She was just seven years old, orphaned after her mother tragically killed her father and was sentenced to life in prison.

With no family and nowhere to go, Julianna was taken in by a local Pastor who knew Julianna needed more—she needed stability, love, and the opportunity to thrive. So, he made a long journey across Ghana with Julianna to Kumasi to the newly founded House of Grace.

Julianna had no idea she was about to walk into the place that would change her life forever.

She spoke only her tribal language, Dagbani, and was frightened and alone, but Julianna quickly learned Twi, becoming a mentor and translator for the next nine girls—each from remote villages, each dealing with their own trauma



Julianna helped the other girls adapt, grow, and find comfort in their new home. She remained at House of Grace through 9th grade, finished high school, and is now in her second year of university, studying to become a social worker. Her dream? To return as the future Director of House of Grace—Ghana.

Julianna's story is one of hope, transformation, and purpose—but it's also a story made possible by people who gave generously.

There are more children just like Julianna—waiting for a safe place to land, a loving hand to guide them, and the chance to discover the purpose God has for their lives.

Global Servants has built dormitories, cafeterias, kitchens, gyms, playgrounds and anything else girls might need as they grow. Global Servants pays all the medical bills and all the school fees. By investing in these wonderful girls,

Clean Water Impact Story

A Well of Hope in Gbimsi

Because of our supporters, lives are forever changed

In the remote village of Gbimsi, on the edge of Ghana's northern desert, access to water was a daily struggle. The village church and school—serving over 350 children—had no well. Students walked miles to the river just to get water or hold class under the scorching sun. Teachers and pastors did what they could, but the need was overwhelming.

That changed when Global Servants stepped in.

Thanks to the generosity of our partners, a clean water well was drilled in Gbimsi. Today, children can stay in school, teachers can focus on learning—not survival—and the entire village now has reliable access to safe, life-sustaining water. A sanitation station was also built, and electricity is on the way, multiplying the impact for years to come.








Protecting Health, Preserving Dignity






Our Education Initiatives Breaks The Cycle of Poverty






