Travel Tips – Prepare for Your Journey

- **Passport Validity:**

Ensure your passport is valid for at least six months beyond your travel dates.

- **Vaccinations:**

No vaccines are required to enter Honduras. Consult your doctor for any recommended medications or routine travel health guidance.

- **Currency:**

Honduras uses the Lempira (HNL). Bring some cash or plan to withdraw money from ATMs upon arrival.

- **Phone Access:**

Consider purchasing a local SIM card or activating an international phone plan for communication.

- **Weather:**

Pack light, breathable clothing and a rain jacket. The climate is warm and humid, with occasional rain.

- **Cultural Respect:**

Dress modestly and be respectful of local customs, especially when visiting churches, schools, and villages.

- **Travel Information:**

Visit the U.S. Embassy or State Department website for current travel, safety, and cultural information for Honduras.



Learn Popular Spanish Phrases

Here are some basic phrases in Spanish:

- **Yes** – Sí (see)
- **No** – No (noh)
- **Hi (informal)** – Hola (oh-lah)
- **Hello (formal)** – Buenos días / Buenas tardes (bweh-nohs dee-ahs / bweh-nahs tar-des)
- **Thank you** – Gracias (grah-see-ahs)
- **You're welcome** – De nada (deh nah-dah)
- **Please – Por favor** (por fah-vor)
- **Nice to meet you** – Mucho gusto (moo-choh goos-toh)
- **What is your name?** – ¿Cómo se llama? (koh-moh seh yah-mah)
- **I am...** – Me llamo... (meh yah-moh)
- **Good morning** – Buenos días (bweh-nohs dee-ahs)
- **Good afternoon / evening** – Buenas tardes (bweh-nahs tar-des)
- **Good night** – Buenas noches (bweh-nahs noh-ches)
- **Goodbye** – Adiós (ah-dee-ohs)
- **Have a good day** – Que tenga un buen día (keh ten-gah oon bwehn dee-ah)
- **I don't understand** – No entiendo (noh en-tee-en-doh)
- **Do you speak English?** – ¿Habla inglés? (ah-blah een-glehs)
- **I don't know** – No sé (noh seh)
- **Can you help me?** – ¿Puede ayudarme? (pweh-deh ah-yoo-dar-meh)

What To Bring With You

Cell Phone:

If you do not have an international calling plan or are concerned about charges, you may purchase a local SIM card in Honduras for affordable internet and calling access. Your phone must be unlocked and able to change SIM cards.

WhatsApp:

Your mission team will use WhatsApp to communicate and share photos and updates throughout the trip.

Life360:

An optional app that allows you to share your location with family members while traveling.

Clothing:

Pack lightweight clothing for warm weather. Average temperatures range from the low 70s to high 90s.

Footwear:

Bring comfortable, closed-toe shoes suitable for walking and ministry activities.

Personal Items:

Sanitary wipes, hand sanitizer, sunscreen, and insect repellent are recommended.

Water Bottle:

Bring a reusable water bottle. A filtered or membrane-style bottle is recommended for added peace of mind.

Money for Offerings:

Bring extra cash if you would like to give a special offering or gift during the trip.
