CAMPAIGN FOR SPIRITUAL RENEWAL
KEY PARISH INVESTMENTS



My dear St. John the Baptist Parish Community,

During last Sunday's public launch of *Sowing Seeds of Faith Campaign for Spiritual Renewal*, I highlighted Bishop Cantú's presentation of the six priorities of the Diocesan Pastoral Plan, which are **Worship, Outreach, Formation, Family Ministry, Youth and Young Adults and Structural Renewal**. I mentioned what our Parish Leadership, volunteers and organization members did with those six priorities.

On January 11, 2025, at a general assembly, those parishioners discussed the six diocesan priorities and arranged them in order in such a way that they will become the **Key Parish Investments (KPIs)**. The top three priorities for our Parish are **Worship, Formation and Youth and Young Adults**. As I mentioned, our parish share from the Campaign will be earmarked for these three KPIs. And we will make sure the objectives of those KPIs will be worked on for the coming years. The other three diocesan priorities (Outreach, Family Ministry and Structural Renewal) will still be implemented but in a slower pace.

For **Worship**, we hope to create a profound and wide-ranging culture of hospitality to deepen and increase St. John's parishioners' commitment towards fostering a welcoming worship environment.

We aim to be an inclusive, diverse, and collaborative parish community arising from: (1) a stronger and responsive parish organization; (2) empowered parish groups; (3) enhanced communication strategies; (4) enhanced coordination between Parish and School; (5) reaching out to inactive Catholics and those inquiring about the faith; and (6) funding structural improvements towards a more welcoming gathering space. By doing so, we continuously build our parish community by welcoming all and providing opportunities for fellowship and ministry.

For **Formation**, we hope to develop deep, personal relationships with Jesus Christ.

We aim to develop and implement a quality faith formation program serving young adult, adult, and senior-age parishioners through various life stages, reaching out to spiritual seekers, and welcoming returning Catholics. We will invest in formation events, faith group experiences, retreats, programs, and facilitator trainings, including the hiring of full-time faith formation staff. By doing so, we continuously nurture discipleship among all parishioner sectors in our community.

For **Youth and Young Adults**, we hope to encourage, empower and nurture youth and young adult participation in parish life and leadership so as to guarantee a vibrant parish not only today but also for the future.

We aim to identify areas of participation, engaging, and collaborating with the Youth & Young Adults of the parish towards inspiring and cultivating the future leadership of the parish. Our primary goals are to: 1) invest in a robust Youth & Young Adult (YYA) program and ministry that will promote recruitment, formation/training, and collaboration opportunities to manifest their impact on the parish and 2) fund structural improvements towards a gathering and meeting space for the YYA ministry.

These are the three primary areas of ministry that we will collectively work towards 2027 which is the Sesquicentennial (150th) Anniversary of our Parish and further.

Let us ask God to "bless our efforts to support our Diocesan Pastoral Plan, so that Renewed in Christ, Together in Mission, every ministry may thrive, and every soul may give glory to God. May the seeds we plant today bear fruit for generations to come.

Through the intercession of Saint Joseph, Saint Clare, and the Blessed Virgin Mary, Our Lady of Guadalupe, may we be guided always in faith, hope, and love. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen."
