CAMPAIGN FOR SPIRITUAL RENEWAL
PUBLIC PHASE

My dear St. John the Baptist Parish Community,

In this Sunday's second reading, St. Paul, writing to the Roman Christians, said: *"None of us lives for oneself, and no one dies for oneself. For if we live, we live for the Lord, and if we die, we die for the Lord; so then, whether we live or die, we are the Lord's. For this is why Christ died and came to life, that he might be Lord of both the dead and the living."* (Rom 14:7-9)

The essence of Christian discipleship, like Jesus, is living for others. Life that is not given in love is a life not fully lived. That is why, the life of Jesus of Nazareth, all of 33 years, is a life fully lived because he gave his all.

During this month of September, we celebrate the lives of the Holy Korean Martyrs, *Saints Andrew Kim Taegon and Paul Chong Hasan* and their companions on Sunday, September 20, and the two Filipino martyrs, *San Lorenzo Ruiz* and his companions and *San Pedro Calungsod* on Saturday, September 26, with a Mass at St. John Vianney Church in San Jose at 1 pm.

These ethnic martyrs and many others who gave witness to their faith lived not only for themselves but also for God and others. They made the ultimate sacrifice. They glorified God in life and in death.

As you may know, since January, we have been praying the *Sowing Seeds of Faith* prayer before every Sunday Mass for the success of our Capital Campaign for Spiritual Renewal. May the Lord give success to the work of our hands. This weekend we launch the public phase of the Campaign for Spiritual Renewal. The Campaign is an invitation to grow spiritually as disciples of Jesus. It is seldom that we are invited to be part of an endeavor that is far bigger than ourselves that will take us to a future where the spiritual welfare of future generations of parishioners is being prepared and hallowed by us, the current generation of believers.

The Campaign is aptly called ***Sowing Seeds of Faith Campaign for Spiritual Renewal***. From the prayer itself we gather the theme of the Campaign: ***Renewed in Christ, Together in Mission***. It highlights the many aspects of the Campaign - the spiritual rootedness in Christ, the aim to be renewed in Him, the journey together in the mission of evangelization. Indeed, it is a bold step forward in our journey together in Christ's mission.

This weekend, I am making a public appeal and presenting the case to our Sunday assembly with the fervent hope that we, who live for God and for others, will match our commitment with our financial resources. This year, we did not have the Annual Diocesan Appeal (ADA). We combined it with the Sowing Seeds of Faith (SSF) Campaign. **Our combined goal for both endeavors is \$954,000. For SSF it is \$840,000 which we need to raise in 5 years through pledges, and for this year's ADA, it is \$114,000.** After the end of the Campaign, 50% of what we will raise will stay right here in the Parish for our own needs and identified Key Parish Initiatives (KPI).

One obligation that has been weighing heavily on our shoulders is our existing loan on the Pavalkis Hall, which we have been paying for the last 25 years. We pray that we will work towards retiring that loan.

I am likewise giving an update on our Sanctuary Renovation Project which we hope to finish in time for the celebration of the 150th anniversary of the foundation of St. John the Baptist Parish in 2027. More on that in the coming weeks.

As a community of faith, in which every person plays an important role as members of the Body of Christ, I am asking the rest of you to consider your part by making a pledge to the Campaign. We are depending on 100% participation because we want everyone to have made an investment in this faith that is so important to each of us for future generations of SJB Parishioners.

We stand on the spiritual shoulders of our ancestors in the faith. We are benefitting from their labors and sacrifices. Let the future generations of worshippers stand on our shoulders and the sacrifices we make.

If you wish to have a visit or a sit-down appointment with Father Victor, Sister Myrna or myself, please do not hesitate to reach out to us. We will be happy to talk to you about the future of our Parish, rooted in our common love for God and the Church.

Twenty-fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

SIR 27:30-28:7; PS 103:1-4, 9-12; ROM 14:7-9; MT 18:21-35

Today's readings invite us to examine the state of our hearts — our thoughts, attitudes, and emotions. In our First Reading from Sirach, we hear about the destructive power of anger: "Could anyone nourish anger against another and expect healing from the Lord?"

All of us have been hurt by others at some point, some more deeply than others. While our emotions are gifts from God, we are called to steward them well rather than allowing them to control us. How do we do that? Sirach gives us the answer: "Remember your last days, set enmity aside... Remember the Most High's covenant and overlook faults." Instead of dwelling on past hurts, we choose gratitude. We remember God's countless blessings, His unfailing mercy, and His faithful love, placing our trust in Him.

In today's Gospel, Jesus reminds us of who we are before God through the parable of the unforgiving servant. A king forgives a debt so enormous it could never be repaid, yet the servant refuses to extend that same mercy to someone else.

The story should sound familiar. God has given us life, forgiven our sins through His Son, and opened the way to eternal life. We could never repay such a gift. The only fitting response is to offer Him our whole lives and to extend the same mercy and forgiveness He has shown to us.

That is the freedom and joy found in the stewardship way of life.

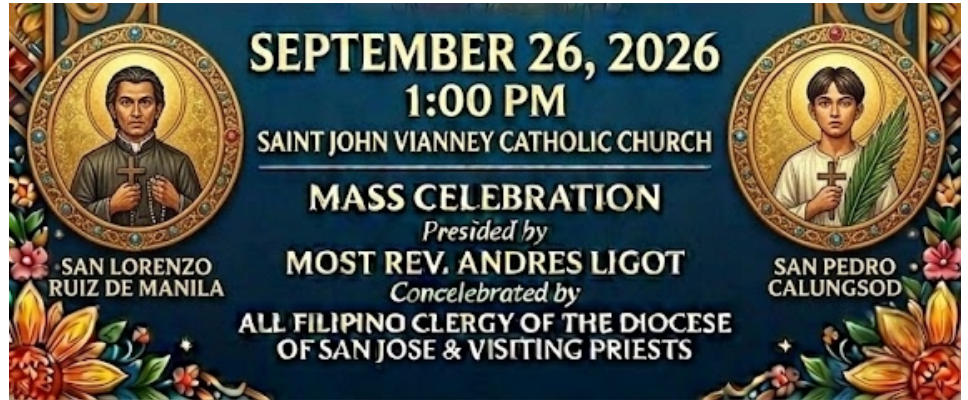
