Scope and Content

The collection consists of an oversized scrapbook created by Josie Edith Chilton (later Treggett) when she was a student at the Potsdam Normal School. The book begins in 1928 and continues to 1931. Chilton was born in Ellenburg Depot, NY. The scrapbook includes dance cards, news clippings, drawings, notes, programs, ephemera, correspondence and more.
