If you are doing regular child observations, and creating activities, this course is perfect for you! You will delve into childhood development and learn how to nurture not only physical but also emotional and social well-being in children.

Achieving your Level 3 will open doors to higher paying roles and make you a professionally recognised Early Years Educator who can be counted in ratio.

What's more, government funding is available for non-levy employers. If you're eligible for funding, and you are under 22 the course is completely free to your employer. If you're over 22, they only pay 5%!

What about classes?

How will I be assessed during my course?

We will work with you and your employer to ensure that you have met all the skills, knowledge and behaviours as set out in the Standard to ensure you are ready to go into your End Point Assessment.

Your monthly learning training plan will be discussed with you during your induction in more detail. Some of the course content will be in the form of tasks for you to complete, quizzes, assignments or online workshops for you to attend to support your learning throughout your apprenticeship.

Your tutor will also visit you at your setting for in-person observations to support you - again in your preparation for your End Point Assessment.

You will benefit from reviews, every 8-10 weeks with you, your tutor and your employer to go through your training plan, what's worked well and what areas need concentrating on.

Functional Skills – risks and implications of opting out.

It's strongly recommended that you take Functional Skills exams if you have not achieved GCSEs in English and maths - and include this during your apprenticeship, as it's fully funded.

Opting out of functional skills is an option. However, it could limit your role in an early years setting, as you may not count towards staff-to-child ratios without a recognised Level 2 English qualification.

This may also impact your career progression as many employers and industry bodies require these core skills.

Managers appointed on or after 4 January 2024 must hold a Level 2 Maths qualification or achieve one within two years of starting their position. Additionally, your setting may face staffing challenges, and your employer is responsible for ensuring compliance with all regulatory requirements.

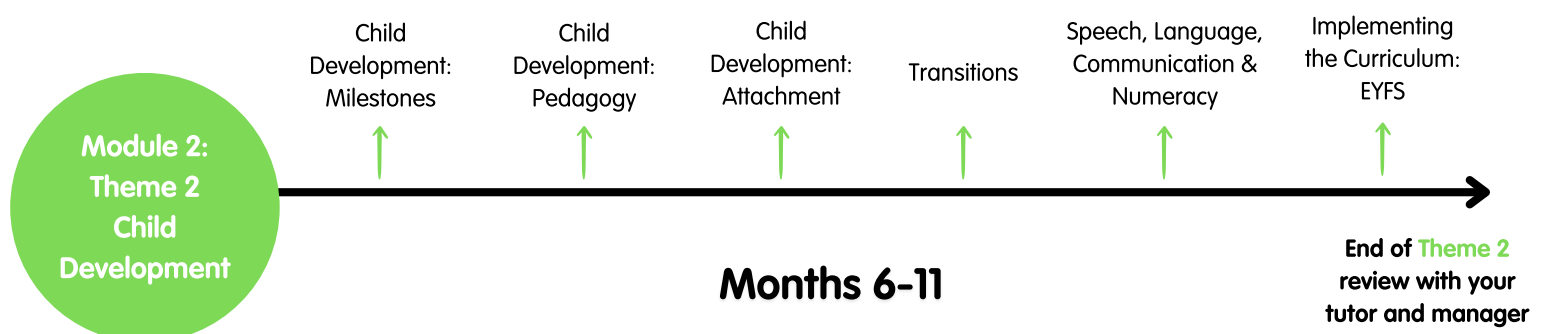

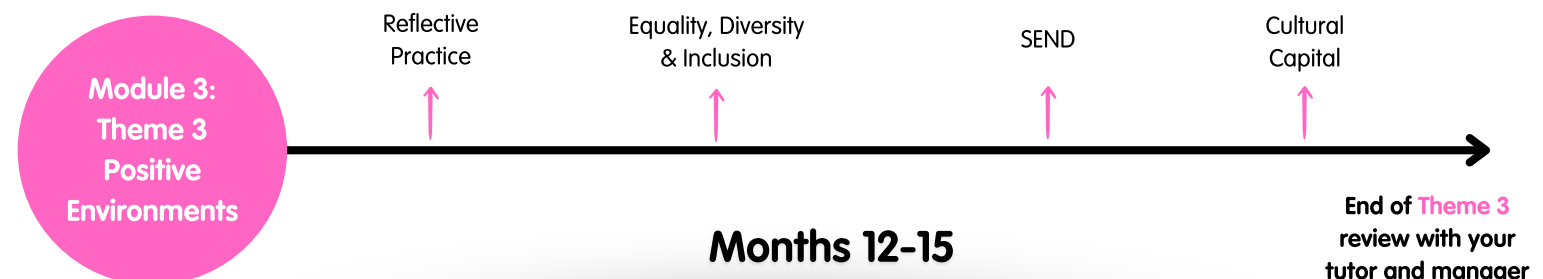

Once you have completed your Training Plan, you will prepare for your End Point Assessment (EPA) – this is called Gateway.

You now have 3 months to successfully complete your EPA

- ▶ For you to be able to enter Gateway, we ensure you have achieved the knowledge, skills and behaviours set out in the Standard, and you hold a valid Level 3 Paediatric First Aid qualification, which you need to be able to practice as a qualified Level 3 EYE
- ▶ Our dedicated EPA team will carry out mock professional discussions with you – giving you feedback in preparation for your EPA.

Your EPA consists of:

- ▶ A 50-minute in-person observation whilst you are in ratio, followed by a 30-minute Q&A session
- ▶ A Professional Discussion around the knowledge, skills and behaviours you have developed during your apprenticeship, which we practice with you in Gateway

Depending on your prior learning, the length of your apprenticeship may be reduced – this will be discussed on your enrolment call with our team.
