PERSONNEL & STUDENT AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

- *Communihealth to present the possibility for a school based clinic at BCS. –Katie Parnell*
Ms. Parnell presented blueprints showcasing how the Business Office could potentially be redesigned to house a school based community clinic. She explained the processes, for example: consent forms are signed by parents at the beginning of each school year for students; students are never billed for services; community members are charged based on a sliding scale; etc. To fund the remodeling project, they are seeking grant funding, such as the Rural Health Transformation Fund. They also receive support from the Living Well Foundation and other sources. Beekman Charter School will be responsible for paying utility expenses for the clinic. No action was taken.
- *HB283 Teachers Shield Act. Interpretation by admin. –Keith Huntsman*
Mrs. Mann explained that this Bill allows employees who have been victims of classroom violence to be granted medical leave without being docked personal sick leave. This Bill has been passed. No action was taken.

- *To earmark debt service money for capital improvements. –Keith Huntsman*
Mr. Huntsman explained that we currently have some funds earmarked for capital improvements. If the tax does not renew, our debt service will drop to nothing. Mrs. Kilcrease added that the final debt service amount for this year was \$258,880.00. If the tax passes, our debt service will increase. Mr. Huntsman further clarified that if the tax passes, the debt service will be the capital improvement money, not in addition to it. Tamika Jones made a motion to earmark debt service money for capital improvements. Seconded by Keith Huntsman. Motion carried.
