

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Louisiana Local Government Environmental Facilities and Community Development Authority (the "**Authority**") on the 11th day of August, 2026 at the offices of the Authority, 5641 Bankers Avenue, Building B, Baton Rouge, LA 70808; at 10:00 o'clock a.m., local time, will conduct a public hearing with respect to the issuance of certain Revenue Bonds (Beekman Charter School Project), in one or more series in an aggregate principal amount of not to exceed Eight Million One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$8,150,000) (the "**Bonds**") to assist Beekman Alumni & Friends, Inc. and/or its successor and assigns (the, "**Borrower**"), by providing financing (i) the construction and improvement, of permanent public junior high school building, classroom facilities and related furniture and equipment at the Charter School, including replacement of existing modular facilities; and (iii) to pay costs of issuance of the Bonds (collectively, the "**Project**").

The location for the proposed Project is: 15190 AM Baker Rd., Bastrop, LA.

The maximum amount of the bond proceeds to be spent on the Project described above is \$8,150,000.

All interested persons are invited to attend such public hearing to express their views with respect to the aforesaid Project and the issuance of the Bonds.

The Executive Director of the Authority shall conduct the public hearing for the purpose of receiving comments on and hearing any objections (verbal or written) to the proposed issuance of the Bonds. All interested parties are invited to attend such public hearing to express their views. Persons who intend to appear at the hearing and express their view are invited to contact Mr. Ty E Carlos, Executive Director, at the Authority's office, either in writing at the office of the Authority set forth above or by telephone (225) 924-6150, in advance of the hearing. Any interested persons unable to attend the hearing may submit their views in writing to Mr. Carlos prior to the date scheduled for the hearing. The location and time of the hearing may be changed, or an additional hearing will be scheduled if requested to do so in written requests submitted to Mr. Carlos prior to the aforementioned date of the hearing by a significant number of interested persons.

The Bonds will be secured and payable solely out of the income, revenues and receipts derived from the funds and accounts held under and pursuant to a Trust Indenture and shall be limited obligations of the Authority. The Bonds shall not be a general obligation of the State of Louisiana, or any political subdivision of the State of Louisiana, nor shall the same give rise to a pecuniary liability of the Authority, the State or any political subdivision thereof or charge against their general credit or taxing power as shall be plainly stated on the Bonds.

This notice is published, and the aforementioned public hearing is to be held in satisfaction of the requirements of Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, regarding the public approval prerequisite to the exclusion from gross income for federal income tax purposes of the interest on the Bonds.
