MINIMUM SERVICES CHARGE



The Minimum Services charge represents the minimum non-declinable services required to facilitate the disposition of a deceased person, whether by cremation or burial. This standard service charge is applicable to every family we serve, no matter what services or options are involved in the final arrangements. The minimum service charge includes, but is not limited to the following:

Additional fees may apply for mileage beyond 40 km, pacemaker/radioactive implant removal and pallbearers (burial only).





MINIMUM SERVICES CHARGE



NOT INCLUDED IN THE MINIMUM SERVICES CHARGE

- any supplies, such as a casket, outer burial container, urn, stationery, etc.
- any additional services that may be selected, such as pallbearers for interment, embalming, visitation and funeral services
- · additional mileage fees beyond 40 km
- pacemaker / radioactive implant removal, if applicable
- applicable taxes (HST)

MINIMUM REQUIRED DISBURSEMENTS, AS APPLICABLE

Cremation fee charged by crematorium: Price varies by crematorium (We will arrange cremation with any crematorium, but we suggest Westminster Crematorium) Coroner's fee (required for cremation, out of province shipments): \$75

Interment fee charged by the cemetery to open and close the grave: Price varies by cemetery

Death registration fee charged by the local municipality: \$55 (Charged in all cases where the death occurs in Ontario)

Bereavement Authority of Ontario Consumer Protection Fee charged by the Bereavement Authority of Ontario (BAO), a government delegated authority and not-for-profit corporation administering provisions of the Funeral, Burial and Cremation Services Act, 2002 (FBCSA) on behalf of the Ministry of Public and Business Service Delivery. This fee applies to each service activity performed and rendered. \$30

ADDITIONAL BODY PREPARATION SERVICES

It is our policy that human remains be identified whenever possible prior to Minimum Service Options, cremation/ graveside services or in all situations where there is to be a closed casket. The identification may be made by anyone who knew the deceased, including a relative, friend, neighbour, co-worker, or clergy person. While identification of a body is possible with the minimum required preparation, you may wish to consider opting for "basic preparation of remains" or embalming, as it might provide a more peaceful and meaningful final viewing experience. Embalming is not legally required but may be recommended to preserve the body between the time of death and final disposition. One of our funeral directors will be able to guide you on preparation options and make recommendations based on the condition of the body and the expected service needs.

SERVICE OPTIONS

On pages 5-10, you will find samples of our services that are commonly selected by the families we serve, however, there are many other options available to you. One of our funeral directors can explain your options and help you create a unique service that meets your wishes and honours your loved one in a meaningful way.

NOT included:

- any supplies, such as a casket, outer burial container, urn, stationery, flowers
- any additional services beyond those specified in the package
- · additional mileage fees beyond 40 km
- pacemaker / radioactive implant removal, if applicable
- applicable taxes (HST)
- disbursements to be paid on your behalf, such as the cemetery interment fee, crematorium fee, coroner's fee, death registration fee, musicians, Clergy/Celebrant




This includes all services in the Minimum Services charge, plus: four hours of visitation at the funeral centre, followed by a funeral service the next day in our chapel, embalming, dressing and basic hairdressing services; professional staff supervision and guidance throughout the visitation and service; the use of a visitation suite including equipment to display personal items and floral tributes; use of a coffee lounge during the visitation, the use of our facility on the day of the funeral service, the assistance and direction of our staff, flower/equipment vehicle, (7-passenger family limousine-if required) and funeral coach (in lieu of a van) to the grave/mausoleum or crematorium as applicable.

This includes all services in the Minimum Services charge, plus: four hours of visitation at the funeral centre followed by a funeral service/mass the next day at a place of worship or other venue of the families choice, embalming, dressing and basic hairdressing services; the use of a visitation suite including guidance throughout the visitation and service; the use of a visitation suite including equipment to display personal items and floral tributes; use of a coffee lounge during the visitation, the assistance and direction of our staff, flower/equipment vehicle, 7 passenger limo (9-passenger family limousine-if required), and funeral coach (in lieu of a van) to the grave/mausoleum or crematorium as applicable.

This includes all services in the Minimum Services charge, plus: 1 hour of visitation in the funeral centre chapel, followed by a funeral service in our chapel or suite, embalming, dressing and basic hairdressing services; professional staff supervision and guidance throughout the visitation and service; the use of a visitation suite including equipment to display personal items and floral tributes; use of a coffee lounge during the visitation, the use of our facility, the assistance and direction of our staff, flower/equipment vehicle, and funeral coach (in lieu of a van) to the grave/mausoleum or crematorium as applicable.

This includes all services in the Minimum Services charge, plus: visitation and service at a place of worship or other venue of the families choice, embalming dressing and basic hairdressing services; professional staff supervision and guidance throughout the visitation and service; the use of equipment to display personal items and floral tributes; the assistance and direction of our staff, flower/equipment vehicle, 7 passenger limo (9 passenger family limousine – if required), and funeral coach (in lieu of a van) to the grave/mausoleum or crematorium as applicable.

CELEBRATION OF LIFE MEMORIAL SERVICE




This includes all services in the Minimum Services charge, an hour of visitation (in the chapel), plus a one hour scheduled use of our chapel for the service, this includes equipment to display personal items and floral tributes, for the visitation and the memorial service. The cremated remains may or may not be present, as chosen by you. You may also wish to have a private family viewing before the cremation takes place.

GRAVESIDE SERVICE



This includes all services in the Minimum Services charge, plus: dressing and basic hairdressing services; staff services for the graveside service, and funeral coach (in lieu of a van to the grave/mausoleum as applicable. No visitation suites or chapel are used for ceremony, as all services take place at the graveside.



STAFF SERVICES



Professional and Staff Services \$1,350

Professional consultation with licensed personnel, including but not limited to expert advice on options to meet your religious and non-denominational needs, assisting families with a variety of ways to celebrate their loved one's lives lived. Co-ordination of funeral details with an officiant, clergy, or celebrant, organizing of funeral home staff and vehicles, and advice regarding possible government benefits. Coordination of all details, before, during and after they have been provided by us, and those provided by third-party suppliers, such as the cemetery, crematorium, florists, and media outlets (death notices). Also included are overhead expenses such as maintenance and utilities, accounting and office administration, insurance and 24-hour access to emergency assistance.

Documentation \$500

Completion and filing of all documents necessary to carry out the services and supplies requested, including, but not limited to death registration, burial permit, coroner's certificate, clergy record where required, cremation application or interment permission form. Third-party fees charged for these documents are not included and are itemized as disbursements on page. We also provide 10 proof of Death certificates for estate settlement purposes. Proof of Death certificates are provided to the deceased's authorized representative as a service only and are not a legal government document; however, they are usually accepted for most estate settlement purposes. Sometimes a provincial "Certified Death Certificate" will be necessary and is available for purchase from the Office of the Registrar General, or through us as a disbursement.

Minimum preparation of remains \$95

(requires "Facilities for preparation/embalming/shelter")

This service is a minimum requirement. The body is checked for personal effects (which will be returned to the authorized representative, unless otherwise instructed) and placed into the casket selected.

OR

Basic preparation of remains \$350

(requires "Facilities for preparation/embalming/shelter")

This service includes those described in "Minimum preparation of remains" above, plus bathing, dressing, the setting of facial features for identification or viewing without embalming, basic hairstyling and cosmetics if desired.

OR

Embalming \$695

(requires "Facilities for preparation/embalming/shelter")

Embalming is the process of replacing blood and bodily fluids with chemical preservatives. It is a process of sanitation, restoration, and temporary preservation. This service includes those described in "Basic preparation of remains" above. If the decedent's cause or suspected cause of death is communicable or infectious, there will be an additional fee of \$500.



STAFF SERVICES



Staff services for Visitation (Same Day \$550) \$1,200

Staff to coordinate and oversee the visitation for a period up to 4 hours. Includes but is not limited to setting up the room/area i.e. floral arrangements, pictures, memorabilia, casket/urn, cleaning, sanitizing, answering phones, greeting, directing visitors, supervision of parking, and provision of lounge services (coffee & tea included). For visitation periods prior to a ceremony, this charge covers the time from the beginning of visitation up to the start of the ceremony, even if the staff present are the same staff provided for the ceremony.

Staff services for each additional visitation room \$475 Staff Services for second day of visitation \$695

Staff services for off-site ceremony \$895

Staff Attendance at Place of Worship or Any Other Venue. Staffing requirements to facilitate services at a place of worship or any other venue. Includes staff attendance, set-up, direction, and coordination of service details. Fee does not include clergy, church, musician, honorarium

Staff services for on-site ceremony \$550

At least one licensed funeral director and assistants to coordinate and oversee the ceremony in our chapel or suite for up to 1 hour. Includes setting up the chapel, floral arrangements, pictures, memorabilia and the casket or um. Cleaning, sanitizing, greeting, directing visitors, and supervision of parking are all included too.

The above two charges are from the time the funeral service begins to the final disposition at the cemetery / crematorium /and are separate from staff services for visitation, even if the staff present are the same staff that were present for the visitation.

Staff services for witnessing of cremation \$300

Funeral home staff required to attend and facilitate witnessing at the crematorium with the family present. Does not include the cost of cremation.

Staff services for Urn Committal \$475

Funeral home staff to coordinate and oversee graveside/cryptside of cremated remains when a committal is not on the day of funeral service.

Staff services for graveside service \$550

At least one funeral director and staff to coordinate and oversee a graveside committal service.

Staff services for a ceremony on a
Statutory Holiday \$875
Staff services for visitation on a
Statutory Holiday up to four hours \$995

Pallbearers \$1,170 (\$195 each)

Fee to hire a pallbearer to assist in carrying the casket from chapel or the place of worship to the coach (hearse), and then from coach (hearse) to crypt or grave. A minimum of six pallbearers are required to carry a casket.



STAFF SERVICES



Staff services for Reception \$495

Staff to coordinate and oversee the gathering of family and friends for up to two hours. Includes the coordination of all catering. One server is provided for up to 40 guests. An additional server is required for every additional 30 guests at a cost of \$175. A hot menu may require additional servers.

\$200

*Smart-Server One Smart-Server required per 50 people

International Transportation of Cremated Remains from Canada \$705

Arrangements to co-ordinate the transfer of cremated remains from Westminster Funeral & Reception Centre to another country. This charge is applied in addition to the minimum services charge. Includes the fee for obtaining certified documentation additional reauired international transportation but does not include the cost of the document itself which is charged as a disbursement. Shipping containers, airfare, government, consulate, coroner, health department and other disbursement fees are not included.

International Transportation of Cremated Remains to Canada \$705

Arrangements to co-ordinate the transfer of cremated remains from another country to Westminster Funeral & Reception Centre. This charge is applied in addition to the minimum services charge. Shipping containers, airfare, government, consulate, airport fees and disbursement fees are not included.

International Transportation of Human Remains to Canada \$705

Arrangements to co-ordinate the transfer of the decedent from outside of Canada to Westminster Funeral & Reception Centre. This charge is applied in addition to the minimum services charge. Shipping containers, airfare, government, consulate, coroner, health department and other disbursement fees are not included.

International Transportation of Human Remains from Canada \$1.695

Arrangements to co-ordinate the transfer of the decedent from Westminster Funeral & Reception Centre to another country. This charge is applied in addition to the minimum services charge. Includes the fee for obtaining additional certified documentation required for international transportation but does not include the cost of the document itself which is charged as a disbursement. Shipping containers, airfare, government, consulate, coroner, health department and other disbursement fees are not included.

Removal of pacemakers or other implants \$165

This procedure is mandatory prior to cremating a body that has a pacemaker or other implant and must be carried out by a licensed funeral director. Includes disposal of device. If a person was undergoing brachytherapy (radioactive theraseeds) or radioisotope treatments before death, it is possible that the deceased may not be able to be cremated; please speak with one of our funeral directors for more information.



FACILITIES



Facilities for preparation/ embalming/ shelter \$250

A secure and private room used to prepare, embalm, and/or shelter the body until the time of burial, cremation, or alternative disposition. This charge applies whenever the body is in our facility. If the deceased is to be held in our facility beyond a period of 5 days, a daily body storage fee of \$65 may apply.

Facilities for visitation (Same Day \$595) \$1,095

requires Staff services for visitation

Use of designated suite for visitation for up to 4 hours for a gathering of friends and or family. This charge is from the beginning of visitation (up to the start of the ceremony), even if the ceremony is in the same room. Catering is available but not included, and details are provided later. Coffee lounge with a hostess is included.

Second visitation suite (up to 4 hours) \$550 Second day of visitation (up to 4 hours) \$550

Facilities for Ceremony \$700

requires Staff services for ceremony

Use of designated facilities for the funeral service (body/casket is present) or memorial service (urn/cremated remains may or may not be present) for up to I hour. This charge is from the time the funeral service begins to the conclusion of the ceremony or final disposition at the cemetery and is separate from Facilities for visitation, even if the visitation was immediately before and in the same room. (audio-video amenities, Flower stands, religious equipment, and memory boards are all available and included in the cost)

Private coffee lounge during vistation \$895

Overflow Facilities \$650

Designated facilities and set up of an additional room with closed circuit broadcasting of the ceremonial service when primary room capacity is exceeded.

Private Family Viewing

A private gathering of immediate family to view and identify the deceased. This intimate gathering is limited to 10 family members for a maximum of 30 minutes. This does not include a ceremony or public visitation.

Reception Gathering

Facilities for any gathering where food and beverages are to be served. Catering is at an additional cost and is coordinated by the funeral home. We offer a variety of menus to choose from starting at \$7 per person. Coffee, tea, soft-drinks, dish-ware, cutlery, use of the kitchen, audio/visual equipment are included.

Facilities for Reception \$650

requires Staff services for reception

Use of the reception room for up to 2 hours. Includes set-up and clean-up.

Room for Private Meal \$300

For up to 30 guests between the afternoon and evening visitation. Catering and servers are at additional cost and are coordinated by the funeral home.

^{*} Serving of alcohol requires the hiring of a Smart-Server.

VEHICLES



Initial transfer from place of death (1 person) \$575

Use of a transfer vehicle, trained staff, and specialized equipment used to transfer into our care from the place of death (hospital, nursing home or residence) Additional mileage fees apply beyond 40 km.

2 PERSONS - \$650

For circumstances that require 2 staff members for a transfer, i.e., coroner's office, hospices, long term care homes, personal residence.

For a transfer done outside of our regular business hours of 8a.m. to 9 p.m.,

there is an additional fee of \$300

Administration vehicle \$125

General duty vehicle used to register the death, pick up cremated remains from the crematorium, make off-site arrangements

Clergy/Lead off-site \$325

This vehicle is required by the funeral director to lead the procession from the Chapel or other venue to any cemetery or crematorium within 40 km. It may carry up to four passengers including Clergy/Officiant/Celebrant for a 3-hour use. (Each additional half hour is \$50)

Clergy / Lead vehicle on-site \$295

This vehicle is required by the funeral director (and Clergy if present) to lead the procession from the Funeral Centre facility to grave or crematorium within the cemetery grounds. It may carry up to three passengers of your choice. The on-site vehicle does not leave the cemetery grounds. (3-hour use)

Final transfer of remains using a service van

\$300

Vehicle and staff to transfer the deceased to the final place of disposition.

On-site funeral coach (hearse) \$395

Required for transportation of the casket from the Funeral Centre facility to the family grave, mausoleum, or crematorium. The on-site funeral hearse does not leave the cemetery. (3-hour use)

Off-site Coach \$550

The coach is required for transportation of the casket from the Chapel or other venue to any cemetery or crematorium within 40 km. 3 hour use.

Additional time charged at \$120 per hour

Family Car / Limousine \$695

Limousine and driver to transport family on the day of the funeral, for up to 3 hours and up to 7 passengers. (Additional time charged at \$120 per hour) 9 passenger limousines are also available for \$725

Additional time charged is \$120 per hour

Flower / Equipment vehicle \$250

Used for the delivery of floral arrangements, memorabilia, and equipment to the place of visitation, service and/or final disposition as required for up to $2\ \text{hours}$

Additional time charged at \$120 per hour

Additional mileage one way (up to 40km radius) \$3.50 per km

Includes blue stitched register book, up to 100 Memorial Cards, 50 Thank You Cards, and Graphic Design.

Signature Stationery Package \$790

Includes custom register book with up to 15 personal pictures, up to 200 Memorial Cards, 100 Thank You Cards, One Round Glass Candle, Framed 8x10 Portrait (black, white or Oak), Custom Video Tribute, 6 pairs of pallbearer gloves.

Premium 2 pc suit (all colours), stretch cotton dress shirt, silk neck tie, black or brown dress shoes - next day service.

Web-casting of Funeral Service \$250

Live-streaming of the funeral/memorial service in any of the visitation suites or the chapel at the Funeral Centre. The service is live-streamed on a single mounted camera at a fixed static angle. Broadcast is limited to the indoor event within the chosen room and concludes once the service has ended.

Equipment for visitation at a remote location \$500

Deliver, set up and use of equipment necessary for visitation at a location other than the funeral establishment.

Hairdressing \$150

While basic hairstyling is included in the Embalming fee, cut and/or color services are additional.

Refundable Deposit for Cremated Remains \$350

When human remains are to be cremated, payment of a refundable deposit may be required. If the cremated remains are not claimed within one year of the cremation, the deposit may be used to inter the cremated remains in common ground in a cemetery of the funeral home's choosing. If the cremated remains are claimed before they are interred, the deposit will be refunded.



ADDITIONAL SERVICES

Additional Shelter \$65 per day

The sheltering of the decedent in a secured, monitored and private area after the five days included in our Facilities for Sheltering fee have past.

Expedited Cremation \$450

This surcharge is applied when cremated remains are to be available to the family within 3 business days from arrangement date.

Interment Fees Vary

This fee is charged by the cemetery for the opening and closing of the grave. The fee varies by cemetery and by the size and depth of the grave.



ESTATE SERVICES

Professional services that assist families with the accurate and timely completion of necessary forms and documents after the passing of a loved one.

DISBURSEMENTS

Disbursements are items arranged for and possibly paid for on your behalf by the funeral home to third party providers. Any prices quoted in this section are subject to change without notice. Such items include but are not limited to:

Bereavement Authority of Ontario Consumer Protection

\$30

Fee charged by the Bereavement Authority of Ontario (BAO), a government delegated authority and not-for-profit corporation administering provisions of the Funeral, Burial and Cremation Services Act, 2002 (FBCSA) on behalf of the Ministry of Public and Business Service Delivery. This fee applies to each service activity performed and rendered.

A "service activity" includes the interment of a casket, interment of cremated remains, entombment of a casket in a mausoleum crypt, entombment of cremated remains within a niche, the scattering of cremated remains, re-opening of a grave to place second remains on top (if not already at extra depth), the cremation of human remains and/or for the professional consultation and arrangements of a funeral service by a funeral director.

Cremation

Fees Vary

This fee is charged by the crematorium for the cremation of the body. The fee varies by crematorium.

Coroner

\$75

This is a provincially set fee charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation/alternative disposition or 'Out of Province' shipping to take place.

Municipal Death Registration \$55

This is a fee charged by the local municipality to register the death on behalf of the Province of Ontario. The municipality issues a burial permit, then forwards the registration documents to the Office of the Registrar General in Thunder Bay.

Minimum requirements for a casket:

For Burial: The least expensive wood casket is suitable and is required by most cemeteries' by-laws for interment this is in the interest of the health and safety of the workers involved in the interment process. A metal casket may also be used for burial.

For Cremation: A body must be presented to the crematorium in a rigid, leak-proof casket that is made of a combustible material, such as wood or cardboard. Caskets containing non-flammable, hazardous material or chlorinated or fibre-reinforced plastic, other than incidental metal, cannot be used for cremation.
