



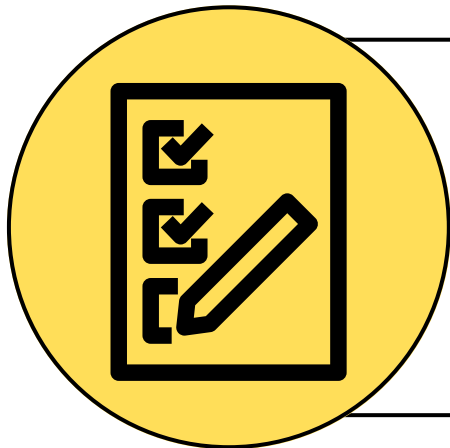
ADULT DIAGNOSTIC (AUTISM, ADHD) MULTIDISCIPLINARY ASSESSMENT



A Multidisciplinary Assessment (with an eligible diagnosis) is accepted by the NDIS. This means you will see a Psychologist and a Speech Pathologist OR Occupational Therapist. We may ask some questions that overlap but both interviews are required for this diagnosis.

ADHD medication: please note you do not need an assessment from a psychologist for ADHD in order to receive medication. In most cases, it is easier and more cost effective to go straight to a psychiatrist. Psychiatrists will need to do their own due diligence due to prescribing schedule 8 medications and some may not accept my report. Every psychiatrist has a different process.

Payments are due at the time of booking. Report payments are due at the completion of the Interview stage.



01. PREDIAGNOSTIC TESTING - FEE \$232.99

We will email tests to you and to a Trusted Other Adult. This may be a spouse, sibling, adult child, work colleague or someone similar.

Review the info sheet for Prediagnostic Testing for further information. Deduct this from the total if you have already completed this.

02. ASSESSMENT INTERVIEW 1 - PAYMENT \$475.60

1 x up to 3 hours telehealth session (can request in person but this may take longer to schedule).

This is a detailed assessment (Psychologist) that will explore the developmental, social & medical background of the Client.



03. ASSESSMENT INTERVIEW 2 - PAYMENT \$475.60

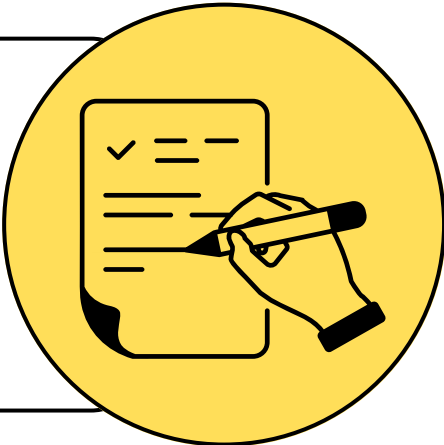
1 x up to 1 hour telehealth session.

This is a detailed assessment (Speech Pathologist or Occupational Therapist) that will explore the developmental, social & medical background of the Client.

04. REPORT WRITING - PAYMENT \$475.60

To explain the findings and any recommendations. Following feedback, NDIS reports will be completed.

We will complete a Psychosocial Capacity Assessment Overview, a Diagnostic Assessment and NDIS Access Request Form.



05. ASSESSMENT HANDOVER - PAYMENT \$475.62

To explain the findings and any recommendations.

A MULTIDISCIPLINARY assessment is an accepted pathway into the NDIS (with eligible diagnoses). For medication, you will still need to consult a Psychiatrist.
