Early Years Foundation Stage

The percentage of pupils achieving a good level of development is 60%.

The Phonics Screening Check

The percentage of children passing the phonics screening check in Year 1 is 80%

The percentage of children passing the phonics screening check by the end of Year 2 is 89%

The Multiplication Check

The percentage of children scoring 80% and above in the multiplication check in Year 4 is 63%

Progress Scores

This year, the government won't publish data on primary school pupil progress because there are no key stage 1 SATs results to provide a baseline. Progress is normally based on a comparison between key stage 1 and key stage 2 SATs results. However, because of the covid pandemic, key stage 1 SATs were cancelled along with all other school tests in 2020 and 2021. Therefore the government will instead will only publish the usual attainment measures. Our performance against other schools can be found via the Department for Education's School Performance Table.
