MAINTENANCE

Hello everyone.

The course has now been open a little over two weeks and the grass is already starting to green up. It looks like it's going to be a nice warm spring for the coming weeks so that should help speed things along.

This past week we have pressured up the irrigation system and now have water on the course, as well as number 5 bathroom.

This coming Tuesday (May 6th) is our annual dry-ject application. This is much different than standard aeration, because dry-jecting actually injects sand with a waterjet about 4" down into the greens profile. Some of the benefits



of this method are reducing thatch levels, introducing new sand into the soil profile, creating more air exchange, and opening the ground up to absorb more water and

nutrients. We also plan to take advantage of being closed on May 6th to verticut tees, aprons, and fairways.

Moving into May we will continue lowering the heights of the greens until we get to our ultimate summer mowing height. We are also going to start edging and sifting all of our bunkers starting in the next week or two.

As the weather progressively gets more consistent, we will see overall course conditions improve and green up. I am looking forward to a great season and moving forward into summer.
