WHAT: Prattville CityFest 2026

WHEN: Saturday, May 2, 2026 - 9 A.M. to 4 P.M.

WHERE: Historic Downtown Prattville, Alabama

SELECTION: Approximately 200 exhibitors will be accepted for CityFest by a panel who serve on the selection committee. All applicants will be screened by this committee, which has been selected on the basis of expertise in either an overall or specific area and/or crafts. The decision of this panel on all applications is final.

ELIGIBILITY: A photograph of work must accompany each application. The selection committee will make decisions based on work represented in the photographs. If two vendors share an exhibit space, both must submit photos. All photos will be returned if accompanied by a self-addressed and adequately stamped envelope. The selection committee does not assume any liability for loss or damage and recommends original photographs not be submitted.

DEADLINE: Entries must be received by April 3, 2026. No refunds will be granted for cancellation after April 3, 2026 except under extreme circumstances.

EXHIBITING All means of display should be provided by the exhibitor. Tables and chairs will not be provided.

INSTRUCTIONS: **A COVER SHOULD BE BROUGHT IN CASE OF RAIN OR EXTREME HEAT.** All materials/supplies/exhibits must be contained within the allotted space. Exhibit spaces will be approximately 12' x 15'.

FEE SCHEDULE: Booth space: Standard \$150.00 space; Premier \$200.00 (Prime location by 124 West Main venue for higher traffic) After April 3 booth prices increase \$100.

APPLICATION All fees should be paid in advance to secure your booth. A signed registration form must accompany each application. Make checks payable to Prattville Chamber. Checks will be deposited upon receipt. **PLEASE DO NOT SEND CASH.**

REFUND POLICY: The space fee will be fully refunded to exhibitors who are not selected. Those applicants accepted by the selection committee will be sent space assignments, maps, and other pertinent information after April 17, 2026.

ENTERTAINMENT: Prattville CityFest has live, continuous stage entertainment. Continuous children's games and activities are conducted in a designated children's area. Business and civic exhibits are interspersed with craft exhibits.
