A WORD FROM FATHER JIM

This Sunday is the World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly. Pope Francis established this special day back in 2021. Pope Francis selected the Sunday closest to the Feast of Saints Joachim and Anne, the grandparents of Jesus, for the celebration of this event. The theme of this year's World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly is from the Book of Sirach 14:2, which states, "Blessed are those who have not lost hope." During this Jubilee Year of Hope, Pope Francis intended this day to be an opportunity to reflect on how the presence of grandparents and the elderly can become a great sign of hope in every family and church community. The Church is blessed that Pope Leo XIV is continuing with his predecessor's plans for this special Jubilee Year. This special day has three purposes: 1) to honor grandparents and the elderly; 2) to allow grandparents and grandchildren to show their love for each other; and 3) to help children become more aware of the importance and benefits that older people can offer them.

Here are six themes with regards to grandparents and the elderly and examples of how we can include intentions for them within our own daily prayer.

1) **Gratitude for Life and Family**: Two of the greatest gifts that God bestows on each of us are those of life and family. We should be thankful for all of God's gifts, especially these two, which allow us to have an experience of life and a loving community to grow in.

Example prayer intercession: "Thank you, Lord, for the gift of a long life and for the presence of grandparents and the elderly in my family and community."

2) **Strength and Resilience in Old Age**: Since people are living longer in the modern world, it is important to ask God for His strength and guidance for the elderly and for ourselves as we age, especially in light of physical and/or mental decline.

Example prayer intercession: "Grant all people, Lord, the strength and wisdom to navigate the challenges of growing older."

3) **Fruitfulness and Legacy**: No one wants to feel unwanted or useless. Most people want to be remembered for something good they accomplished. The elderly continue to bear fruit in their own way and they desire to pass on their wisdom and experiences to younger generations.

Example prayer intercession: "May the elderly continue to bear fruit in their lives and the life of the Church by sharing their experiences and wisdom with others."

4) **Intergenerational Connection**: This is to help bridge the generation gaps within families. One important relationship within families is the one between grandparents and grandchildren. Both can find true value, wisdom, and support from the other.

Example prayer intercession: "May the young learn from the lives and stories of the elderly, finding inspiration and guidance for their faith journey."



5) **Comfort and Hope**: Old age presents many challenges, like loneliness and illness. No one wants to be forgotten, especially in their times of greatest need. Our visits, comfort, and prayers are so essential to the care of the elderly and aging.

Example prayer intercession: "We prayer for healing and comfort for those who are experiencing pain, loneliness, or other challenges in their old age."

6) **Healing and Protection**: It is important for us to pray for those who need healing from physical, mental, emotional, or spiritual pain or suffering. It is also crucial to ask God to protect those who are susceptible to harm or injury. Many elderly people live in fear of falling or health issues.

Example prayer intercession: "We ask you, Heavenly Father, for your blessing upon all grandparents and elderly people, especially those who are in need of special care and protection."

May we all take some time this World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly and thank God for the gift of their presence in our lives. May Saints Joachim and Anne pray for them and allow them to encounter their grandson, Jesus, in a special way.






