

#### A WORD FROM FATHER JIM

On Tuesday, August 5, the Church celebrates the Dedication of the Basilica of Saint Mary Major (Santa Maria Maggiore). It is the oldest Marian sanctuary and it is the resting place of Pope Francis and several other popes. According to tradition, Our Lady appeared in a dream to a wealthy, childless couple who wanted to honor her. In the dream, Mary requested that a church be built for her on a site where snow would fall during the summer. The couple reported Mary's request to Pope Liberius, who had a similar dream. On August 5, in the year 358, snow miraculously fell on Esquiline Hill, the highest of Rome's hills. The snow provided a layout of the perimeter of what is now the basilica. Each year, the miraculous snowfall is remembered with the release of white rose petals from the ceiling of the basilica during the feast day Mass. This tradition gives a special nobility to Saint Mary Major's – marking it out as a kind of Marian relic, a place that was desired and planned by the Mother of God herself.

For a while, the basilica was known as Saint Mary of the Crib after it obtained a relic of the Holy Crib, believed to be the one in which Jesus was laid at his nativity. This relic was carried to Rome by Christian refugees from the Holy Land fleeing the Muslim invasion of the seventh century. The basilica still hosts a procession of the Holy Crib every year on Christmas Day. The relic of the holy crib, which is under the papal altar, recalls the importance of the basilica as the 'Bethlehem of the West'. Since Saint Mary Major is a patriarchal basilica, it contains a papal altar used only by the pope himself or a priest to whom he has given special permission. Customarily, the pope celebrates Mass at the basilica each year on the Feast of the Assumption of Mary (*August 15*).

The Basilica is home to the most important of all Marian icons, the Salus Populi Romani (Our Lady Saviour of the Roman People). Tradition attributes the artwork to Saint Luke the Evangelist, who is patron of painters. This name comes from a miracle in which the icon helped shield the city from the approach of the plague. Pope Francis placed all his apostolic journeys under the protection of Our Lady, Salus Populi Romani, stopping off to pray at the icon before his departure from Rome and again on his return. In his final testament, Pope Francis confirmed his request to be buried at Saint Mary Major writing, "I wish my last earthly journey to end at this very ancient Marian shrine where I would go to pray at the beginning and end of each apostolic journey to confidently entrust my intentions to the Immaculate Mother and to thank her for the docile and maternal care." Pope Francis wished that his tomb "be prepared in the niche in the side aisle between the Pauline Chapel — the Chapel of the Salus Populi Romani — and the Sforza Chapel" and "be in the earth; simple, without special decoration and with the only inscription: Franciscus."

Among the other important relics contained within the basilica are the mortal remains of Saint Matthew and Saint Jerome. Some relics of the true cross are preserved in this basilica, housed in a 14th-century cross-shaped reliquary. During this Jubilee Year of Hope, Saint Mary Major is one of the basilicas which has opened its Holy Doors for pilgrims to walk through in order to receive special graces.

Honoring the Dedication of the Basilica of Saint Mary Major is one way in which the Church celebrates the great gift of Mary, Mother of God. May the Blessed Mother pray and intercede for you, especially during this Jubilee Year of Hope.




