A WORD FROM FATHER JIM

This weekend, the Church celebrates the Third Sunday of Advent, also known as Gaudete (the Latin word for "rejoice") Sunday. The Church is rejoicing because we have reached the midpoint of the Advent season. "Lighting the pink candle for joy symbolizes a break from the season's penitential tone, inviting us to celebrate the blessings of Christ's coming. Advent joy calls us to pause and appreciate the presence of God in our lives, looking forward to the fullness of joy that Christmas brings. It's an invitation to reflect this joy through kindness, gratitude, and worship, radiating the light of Christ to those around us." Likewise, the rose-colored vestments give us a break from the penitential purple of the rest of the Advent season.

Joy is the theme of the Third Week of Advent. The joy of Advent is: God's promise fulfilled in the birth of Christ. In other words, our joy should reflect the excitement and gratitude that we have for the coming of Christ, who brings salvation to the world. Hence, this joy is not simply happiness, but rather a profound resilient gladness, which is rooted in the love of God and the fulfillment of His promises.







There will be **NO CONFESSIONS** on Thursday, January 1st, 2026.




The Parish office and facilities will be closed from December 24th, 2025 through January 4th, 2026 for the Christmas and New Year Holiday.


