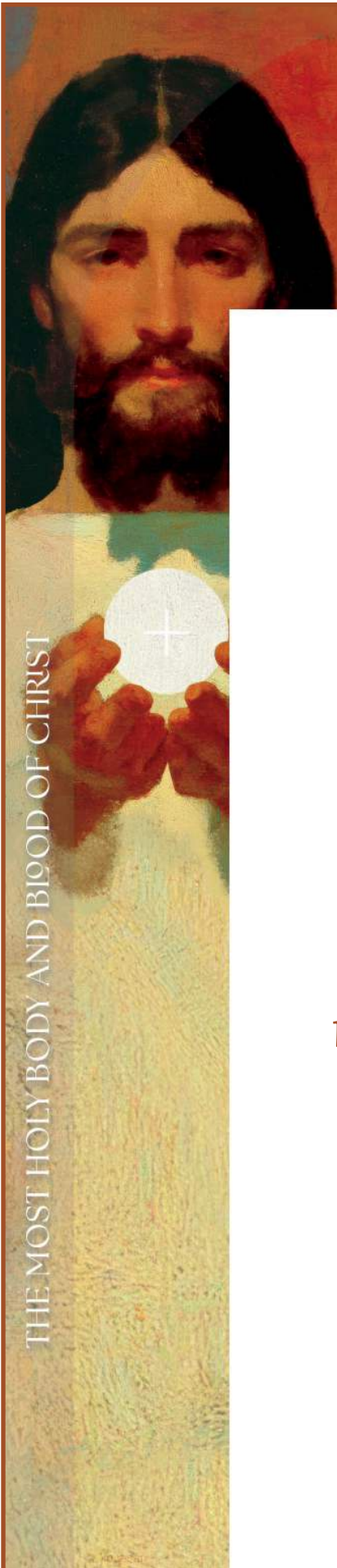

A Word from one of our Seminarians, Vincent Washburn

It has been a while since the parish was updated on my seminary experience and I'm happy to give you all an update on where I have been and what I have been doing! This past school year, I was on Pastoral Year at the Catholic Student Center at USF in Tampa. Pastoral Year is a part of the seminary program and is a year-long internship in a parish to get hands-on ministry experience. Since this was a full-time assignment, that is why you have not seen me very much this year on weekends or holidays. I was blessed to be assigned to the USF Catholic Student Center (where I had also been a member when I was in college) and become part of the amazing community they have built up. The year was full of many unexpected and blessed experiences which allowed me to see myself more and more as a priest and spiritual father to the Church. The students also filled me with great hope for the future of the Church. There is much talk, even in the secular media, of the revival that the United States is seeing in young adults turning back to religion, in particular, Catholicism. Conversions and reversions are skyrocketing and our community at USF was certainly an example of this phenomenon. I am grateful for the experiences I was able to have throughout this past year.

Currently, I am in Toledo, Spain for the summer completing another Spanish immersion program. Some might remember that I did a similar program a few summers back in Guatemala, and since I have more work to do in becoming fluent in Spanish in order to minister to our growing Spanish-speaking community in the diocese, I requested to do another immersion experience this year. I will remain in Spain through the end of July before returning home to continue my studies in the seminary this August. This upcoming year will be my last full year in the seminary before my ordination to the diaconate in April of 2027. Please keep me in prayer, as back in April, the seminary community decided to elect me to serve as president for the next year. It is an honor to be able to serve my community in this way, but your prayers are appreciated as I take on this new responsibility.

Finally, since I am out of the country for the summer and will not be here for Fr. Jim's final weekend with us, I wanted to take the opportunity to thank him publicly for his fourteen years of ministry in our parish (first as parochial vicar and then as pastor). As many of you know, he has had a great influence on me as I grew up and especially as I discerned a vocation to the priesthood. I am grateful for the role he has played in my life and my vocation. May God bless him in his new ministry at Our Lady of Fatima Parish. Know also of my prayers for all of you and our parish community as we welcome Fr. Kovanis to St. Michael's as our new pastor and spiritual father. Please continue to pray for me in my travels and in my studies as I continue towards my upcoming ordinations to the diaconate and priesthood.

unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever.**

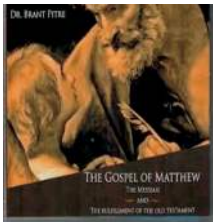

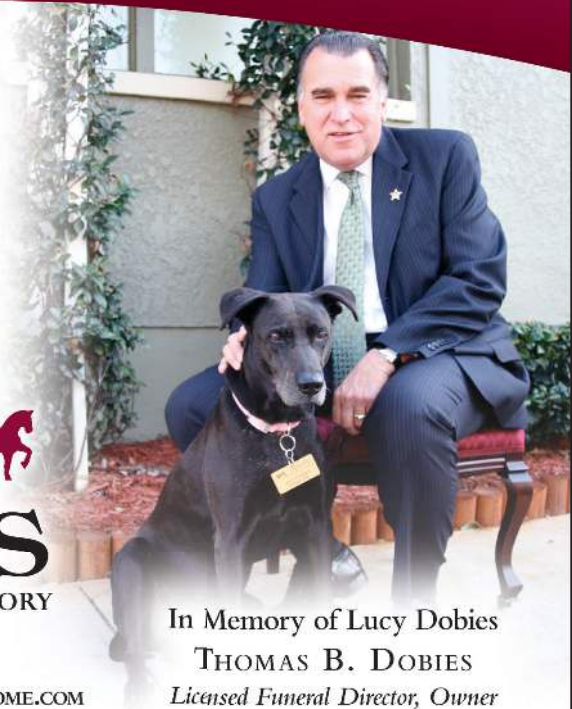
