DISCIPLESHIP BENCHMARKS FOR YOUR CHILD

PRESCHOOL

- Grow in friendship with other kids at church, learning to be kind, to listen, be honest, and be a good helper.
- Begin learning foundational truths: God made them, God loves them, and Jesus wants to be their friend forever through weekly curriculum lessons.
- Learn the Lord's Prayer according to Matthew 6:9-13.

ELEMENTARY

- Grow in friendship with other kids at church, learning to be kind, honest, and a good teammate.
- Begin learning foundational truths in simple terms: made in God's image, the Bible is God's Word, and that Jesus and the Holy Spirit are real and present.
- Take first steps in reading the Bible using a simplified SOAP method (Scripture, Observation, Application, Prayer).
- Learn about the difference between salvation, baptism, communion and discipleship.

MIDDLE SCHOOL

- Grow in Christian community by practicing small group discussion, accountability and working well with others in the Body of Christ.
- Begin a journey of self-discovery rooted in foundational truths: I am made in the image of God, I belong to God, my identity and purpose is rooted in Christ.
- Go deeper in prayer understanding the ACTS prayer model (Adoration, Confession, Thanksgiving, Supplication).

HIGH SCHOOL

- Grow and lead in their community, taking ownership of leading a prayer group on their campus or in their community.
- Deeply Rooted in the word of God, able to articulate and explain their alignment with the Christian faith.
- Accurately exegete Scripture by going deeper in small group discussions and home devotionals.
- Equipped to pray, share the good news and read the Bible confidently.
- Step into leadership roles by serving at church, at home and in their community.
