

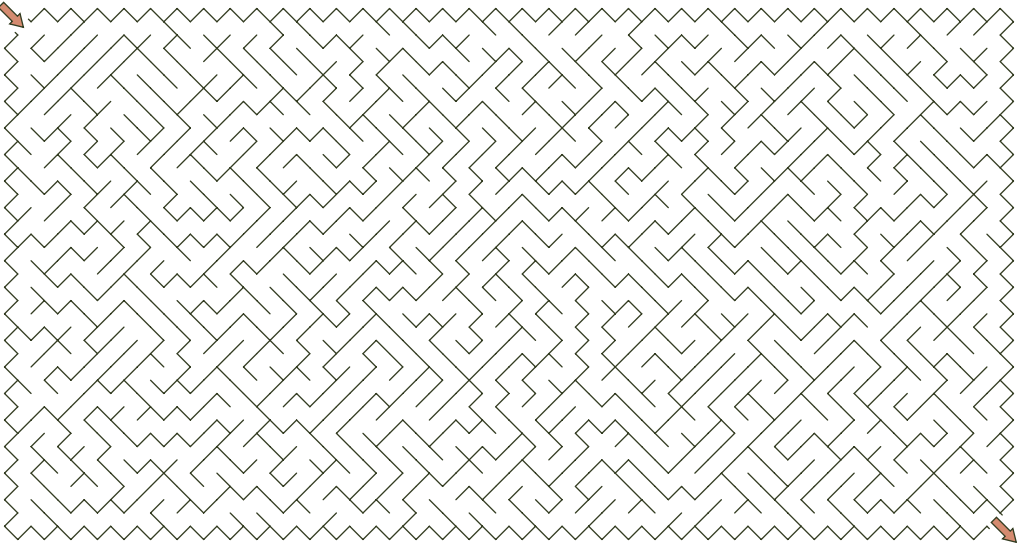

Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds – JAMES 1:2

Is that how James approaches the suffering of others?

No. James understood. He knew what it was like to be persecuted and what it meant to face suffering for the Lord Jesus. James also knew that God sometimes uses trials and challenges in our lives because he wants us to grow in faith. Trials can help us mature in our faith. James wants us to rejoice in this fact, knowing we can trust God always even in troubling times.

Father, it can be hard for us to rejoice when bad things happen in our lives. But help us to trust you in wisdom, knowing we can grow closer to you no matter what happens. Amen.
