Vanity

- ☐ Floating vanity
 - ☐ Wheelchair-accessible vanity
 - ☐ Open knee space
 - ☐ Soft-close drawers
 - ☐ Pull-out organizers
 - ☐ Easy-grip cabinet hardware
 - ☐ Rounded countertop edges
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Step 9 – Plumbing Fixtures

Choose easy-to-use fixtures.

- ☐ Lever-handle faucets
- ☐ Touchless faucet
- ☐ Handheld shower
- ☐ Rain shower
- ☐ Thermostatic controls
- ☐ Anti-scald protection

- ☐ Easy-reach controls

Preferred Finish:

- ☐ Chrome
 - ☐ Brushed Nickel
 - ☐ Matte Black
 - ☐ Brushed Brass
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Step 10 – Lighting & Electrical

Good lighting improves both safety and comfort.

Select desired upgrades:

- ☐ LED vanity lighting
 - ☐ Recessed ceiling lights
 - ☐ Motion-sensor lighting
 - ☐ Night lighting
 - ☐ Under-vanity lighting
 - ☐ Backlit mirror
 - ☐ Dimmable lighting
 - ☐ Additional GFCI outlets
 - ☐ Exhaust fan with lighting
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Step 11 – Bathroom Storage

Storage should be easy to access without excessive bending or reaching.

Choose desired upgrades:

- ☐ Recessed medicine cabinet
- ☐ Floating shelves
- ☐ Built-in shower niches
- ☐ Linen cabinet
- ☐ Pull-out drawers
- ☐ Drawer organizers
- ☐ Tall storage cabinet

- ☐ Wall-mounted shelving
 - ☐ Hidden electrical outlets
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Step 12 – Universal Design Features

Select features that improve usability for everyone.

- ☐ Wider doorway
- ☐ Open floor plan
- ☐ Increased turning radius
- ☐ Curbless shower
- ☐ Lever door handles
- ☐ Minimal thresholds
- ☐ Easy-to-clean finishes
- ☐ Contrasting colors for better visibility
- ☐ Rounded corners
- ☐ Easy-access controls

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Step 15 – Before Construction Begins

- ☐ Finalize all selections

 - ☐ Remove personal belongings
 - ☐ Arrange temporary bathroom
 - ☐ Protect adjacent rooms
 - ☐ Secure pets
 - ☐ Review construction schedule
 - ☐ Confirm product deliveries
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Step 16 – Final Walkthrough

Before final payment:

- ☐ Shower drains correctly
- ☐ Grab bars securely installed
- ☐ Bench securely installed

- ☐ Flooring inspected
 - ☐ Lighting tested
 - ☐ Plumbing fixtures tested
 - ☐ Vanity inspected
 - ☐ Drawers and doors adjusted
 - ☐ Caulking complete
 - ☐ Paint complete
 - ☐ Warranty documents received
 - ☐ Product manuals collected
