Phase 1: Planning & Design (2–6 Weeks Before Construction)

Phase 2: Demolition (Week 1)

 - ☐ Remove drywall (if necessary)

Homeowner Checklist

- ☐ Confirm final layout
 - ☐ Verify all materials have arrived
 - ☐ Discuss any unexpected findings
 - ☐ Keep work area clear

Phase 3: Rough Construction (Week 2)

Contractor Activities

- ☐ Plumbing rough-in
 - ☐ Electrical rough-in
 - ☐ Framing modifications
 - ☐ Ventilation improvements
 - ☐ Structural repairs (if needed)

Homeowner Checklist

- ☐ Confirm plumbing locations
 - ☐ Review lighting placement
 - ☐ Verify electrical outlet locations
 - ☐ Approve any project changes

Phase 4: Drywall & Waterproofing (Week 3)

Contractor Activities

- ☐ Install insulation (if required)
- ☐ Hang drywall

- ☐ Finish drywall
 - ☐ Waterproof shower
 - ☐ Prepare tile surfaces

Homeowner Checklist

- ☐ Verify shower niche placement
 - ☐ Review bench location
 - ☐ Confirm waterproofing progress
 - ☐ Ask questions before tile installation begins

Phase 5: Tile Installation (Week 4)

Contractor Activities

- ☐ Install floor tile
 - ☐ Install wall tile
 - ☐ Install shower tile
 - ☐ Install decorative accents
 - ☐ Apply grout
 - ☐ Seal grout (if applicable)

Homeowner Checklist

- ☐ Verify tile pattern
 - ☐ Confirm grout color
 - ☐ Inspect alignment
 - ☐ Report damaged tile before completion

Phase 6: Fixture Installation (Week 5)

Contractor Activities

- ☐ Install vanity
- ☐ Install countertops

- ☐ Install plumbing fixtures
 - ☐ Install toilet
 - ☐ Install mirrors
 - ☐ Install lighting
 - ☐ Install shower doors
 - ☐ Install accessories

Homeowner Checklist

- ☐ Test faucets
 - ☐ Test shower
 - ☐ Test toilet
 - ☐ Test lighting
 - ☐ Open drawers and cabinet doors
 - ☐ Inspect countertop installation
-

Phase 7: Final Details (Week 6)

Contractor Activities

- ☐ Paint touch-ups
 - ☐ Final trim installation
 - ☐ Final caulking
 - ☐ Complete punch list
 - ☐ Final cleaning
-

Homeowner Checklist

- ☐ Walk through the completed bathroom
- ☐ Test every fixture
- ☐ Check ventilation fan
- ☐ Inspect flooring
- ☐ Verify tile quality
- ☐ Confirm punch-list items completed

- ☐ Receive warranty documentation
 - ☐ Collect product manuals
 - ☐ Make final payment according to contract

First Week

- ☐ Learn recommended cleaning methods
 - ☐ Register products for warranty (if applicable)
 - ☐ Save receipts and manuals
 - ☐ Photograph your completed bathroom
 - ☐ Report any adjustments promptly
-

First Month

- ☐ Inspect grout
 - ☐ Check caulking
 - ☐ Monitor plumbing fixtures
 - ☐ Verify exhaust fan operation
 - ☐ Follow maintenance recommendations

Helpful Remodeling Tips

- ✓Order all materials before demolition begins whenever possible.
 - ✓Keep children and pets away from the work area.
 - ✓Expect some dust and construction noise during the remodel.
 - ✓Hidden conditions, especially in older homes, may occasionally affect the project timeline or budget.
 - ✓Avoid making major design changes once construction has started, as they can increase costs and extend completion time.
 - ✓Communicate regularly with your contractor to stay informed throughout the project.
