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Bathroom Renovation vs. Bathroom Remodel

A **bathroom renovation** updates what already exists by replacing fixtures, flooring, lighting, tile, paint, countertops, and cabinetry while keeping the existing layout. A **bathroom remodel** changes the design or function of the room by relocating plumbing fixtures, removing walls, expanding the space, or installing an entirely new layout.

Renovations generally require less labor, fewer materials, and a shorter construction timeline.

- ☐ Plumbing repairs
- ☐ Electrical upgrades
- ☐ Ventilation improvements
- ☐ Wall repairs
- ☐ Code compliance updates
- ☐ Asbestos or lead remediation (where applicable)

Maintaining a contingency reserve of **10–15%** helps prepare for these unexpected conditions.

Ways to Save Money

- ✓Keep the existing bathroom layout.
 - ✓Refinish or repaint cabinetry when appropriate instead of replacing it.
 - ✓Upgrade plumbing fixtures without relocating plumbing lines.
 - ✓Select durable, mid-range materials that provide long-term value.
 - ✓Order all products before construction begins.
 - ✓Complete all desired improvements during one project rather than spreading work over multiple renovations.
