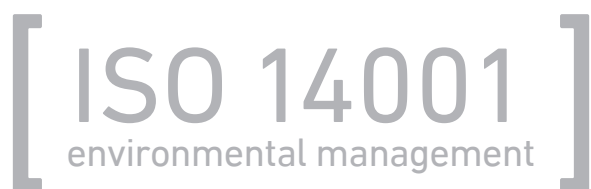
## OUR ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY
