On the acting side, Don was recently seen in a recurring role on the hit TV show – “Glee”, as well as starring roles in the indie films– “MBF”, “Cult Cartel”, “Follow”, “The Yankles”, and “Campin Buddies” . He also just completed filming on the TV Pilot - “Puckheads”.

Most’s other feature film credits include “ED TV”, directed by Ron Howard; “Crazy Mama”, directed by Jonathan Demme, and “The Great Buck Howard”, starring John Malkovich.

In television, his other guest starring roles include “Men Of A Certain Age”, “Century City”, ‘Star Trek: Voyager’, ‘Yes, Dear’, ‘The Crow’, ‘Sabrina’, ‘Sliders’, ‘Dark Skies’ and ‘The Family Guy’.

Following in the footsteps of some of his peers, Don has directed three feature films. “His first, “***The Last Best Sunday***”, had its World Premiere at the Seattle International Film Festival, and was a feature film winner at the Telluride IndieFest. “***Moola***”, starring William Mapother, Shailene Woodley, Treat Williams, Daniel Baldwin, and Curtis Armstrong, premiered at The Newport Beach Film Festival, where it earned Most The Outstanding Achievement In Directing Award. Don also directed “ ***Harley’s Hill***”, his first family film, which was recently seen on Showtime, Starz and Encore.
