Producer and arranger Willie Murillo gathered together a cast of A-list Los Angeles musicians for the dynamic big band backing Most as he does indeed swing his way through a program of 13 standards like “*Love Come Back*,” “*Let’s Fall in Love*,” “*I Got It Bad and That Ain’t Good*,” “*After You’ve Gone*” and “*One for My Baby*.” The influences are surely there, Frank, Dino and Bobby D, but there is no imitation going on here, just a man who loves the songs, and loves to sing them. *Mostly Swinging* is a pleasant surprise from an unexpected source.
