

UCF Market Steer Required Forms – required before you unload on 8/10/26

Since our re-sale steers are purchased by Tyson Fresh Meats in Wallula, we need to meet their paperwork requirements on all the steers as well as having proper "brand paperwork". Please read this message carefully and make sure you print each form, fill out completely and have proper signatures.

This paperwork will be required and reviewed BEFORE you are allowed to unload your steer. If paperwork is not complete you will be asked to pull out of line to complete.

Page 1: Tyson Affidavit: Read thoroughly, complete all blanks and sign (Exhibitor & Parent/Guardian)

Page 2: Tyson Release: Complete all "blanks" including "Parent/Guardian Signature."

Pages 3 & 4: 4-H/FFA Animal Care and Management Disclosure Statement & Treatment Record.

- Be sure to include ALL treatment during period you have owned your steer (vaccination, deworming, treatment for illnesses, etc.).
- Both Exhibitor and Parent/Guardian need to sign.

Page 5: Oregon Transportation Certificate: EVERY exhibitor must have this form showing steer was transported from "home" to EOTEC/UCF.

Page 6: Example of ODA Brand Slip. **IF your steer is branded you must have either** an E-slip (sample attached) or a C-slip (from brand inspector). The OWNER of the brand MUST sign this form. If your family brand is on the steer, this form is required, unless your name is on the brand registry with the State of Oregon. Tyson Supplier Affidavit - Prohibited Feed & Antibiotics

I _____ (print), representing _____ (print) ("Supplier"), represent, warrant, and attest that the following statements are true and correct regarding the cattle provided to Tyson Fresh Meats, Inc. ("Tyson") under my authority, direction, and/or ownership, for slaughter by Tyson:

- Any and all rations fed to cattle have not been fed "prohibited" mammalian protein (i.e. ruminant meat & bone meal) as defined by FDA CFR 589.2000.
- Any and all antibiotics used have been used (i) in accordance with guidelines for responsible use of antibiotics issued by World Health Organization (WHO), World Organization for Animal Health (OIE) and the American Veterinary Medical Association (AVMA), (ii) administered under the auspices of a veterinarian, (iii) in compliance with FDA regulations, and (iv) have not been used solely for the purpose of growth promotion.
- Supplier's cattle have at all times been handled properly, humanely, and in strict compliance with (i) industry standards relating to animal health and welfare, (ii) all applicable federal, state, local laws, and (iii) in compliance with Tyson's Zero Tolerance Policy, Animal Welfare Reporting, and Animal Welfare training policies.

I agree that authorized Tyson officials may conduct inspections of feed records, feed facilities, veterinarian and antibiotic records, and any and all animal health and welfare documentation at locations from which Supplier's cattle were fed and slaughtered at a Tyson facility.

I, as the Supplier or his/her/its authorized agent, represent, warrant, and attest that I am acting under proper authority and that I am duly authorized to make such representations, warranties, and attestations contained herein.

This affidavit shall remain in effect until revoked in writing by the undersigned Supplier and is delivered to Tyson. Failure to have a current, signed affidavit on-record is cause for Tyson to refuse to slaughter any cattle under Supplier's authority, direction and/or ownership. Supplier shall keep the yellow copy of this affidavit for his/her/its records.

This agreement shall remain in effect until Producer has provided TFM with a written notice that Company is no longer authorized to have access to records on the sale of cattle by Producer.

Producer agrees to protect, defend, indemnify and hold TFM harmless from and against any and all claims, actions, liabilities, losses, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorneys’ fees and costs, even if such claims are groundless, fraudulent or false, arising out of any actual or alleged damage to any property, or any other damage or loss, by whomsoever suffered, resulting or claimed to result in whole or in part from TFM providing Producer’s records to Company.

As a youth livestock producer, I understand that I have an obligation to be a responsible producer and that all animals will enter the food chain and become edible food products for the consuming public. This subjects every exhibit animal to all state and federal regulations involving proper drug usage and all Food & Drug Administration, Animal Plant Health Inspection Service, Food Safety Inspection Service, and Environmental Protection Agency regulations.

- We, the undersigned, certify that we have **read, understand and will abide by** all rules and regulations of the local county 4-H & FFA fair, or the 4-H division of the State Fair. We agree to the condition that these exhibit animals (identified on this form) may be screened for violative residues and foreign substances. Also, as a condition of entry, exhibitor agrees to a background check for any past disqualification from other livestock shows.
- We have completed the Treatment Records information on the back of this form for any injectable, water, or feed medication, pesticide or other substance that has been administered to exhibit animals. Use of these products may require additional time to meet legal withdrawal limits before harvest.
- We certify that our exhibit animals have completed any withdrawal time relative to the administration of any legal drug, vaccine or other substance, and are in compliance with applicable FDA and USDA regulations (and similar state regulations) concerning drug residues and withdrawal periods.
- We certify that these exhibit animals have not received drugs that are not in compliance with label indications or, if applicable, the requirements of the regulations codifying the Animal Medicinal Drug Use Clarification Act amendment to the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic act (under the direction of a valid Veterinary/Client/Patient relationship).
- If violations are detected, appropriate state and federal authorities will be notified, and regulatory action can be expected. Also exhibitors will be subjected to penalties as determined by show management.
- Effective 4/1/01 due to concerns of BSE. We certify that, to the best of our knowledge, none of the livestock described herein are adulterated within the meaning of the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act (none of the cattle or sheep have been fed any feed containing protein derived from mammalian tissues, such as meat and bone meal from ruminants, not in compliance with 21 CFR 589.2000).
